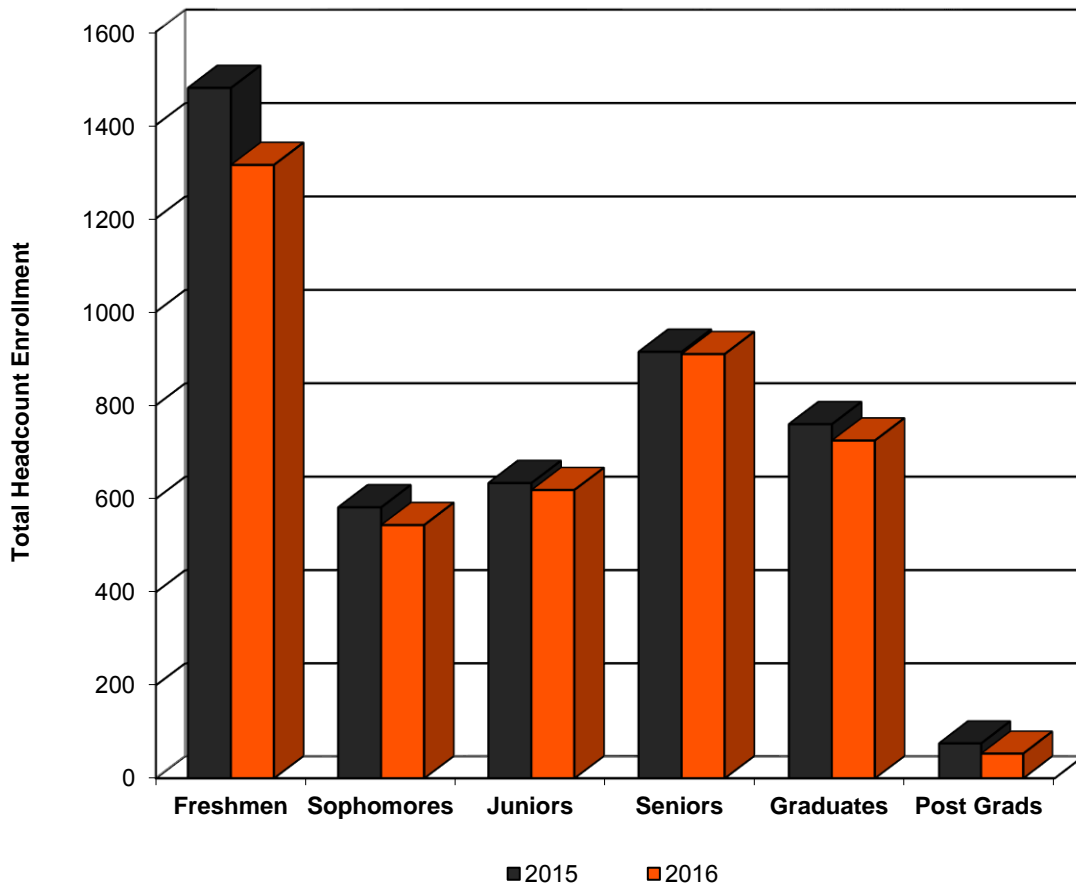
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Fall 2016 Headcount Enrollment Compared to Fall 2015

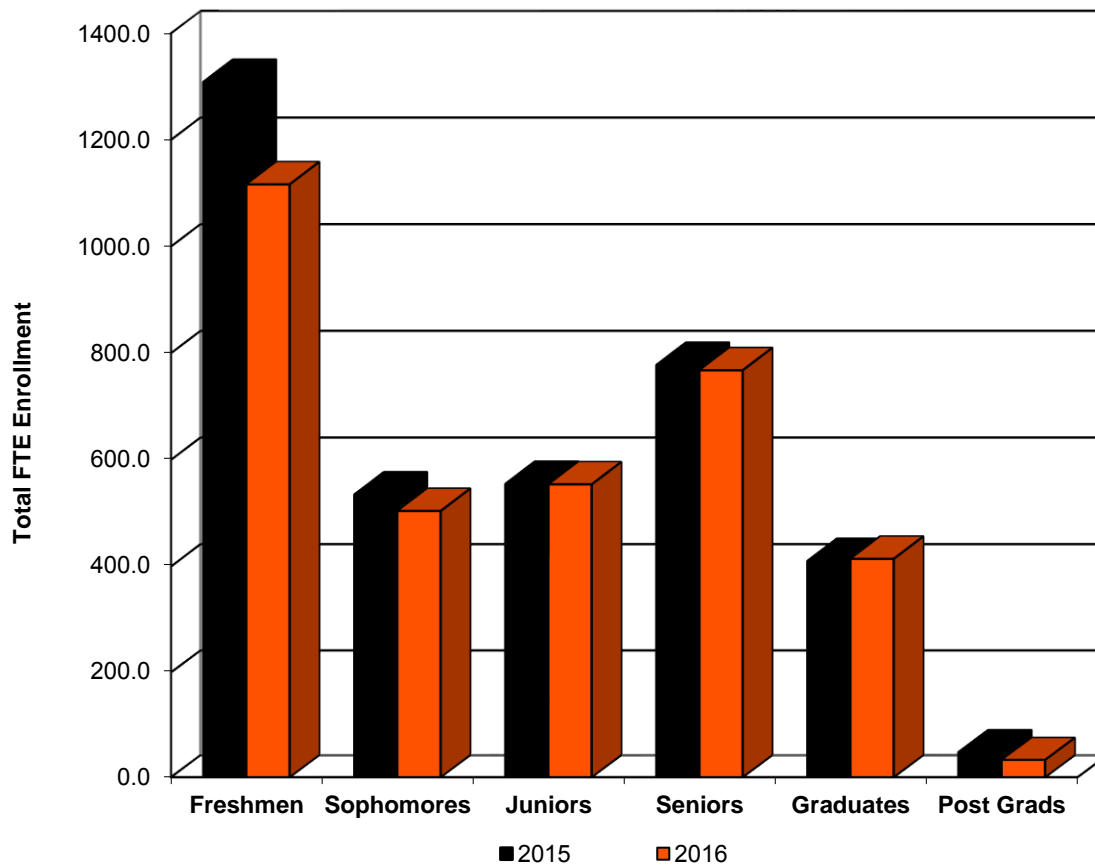

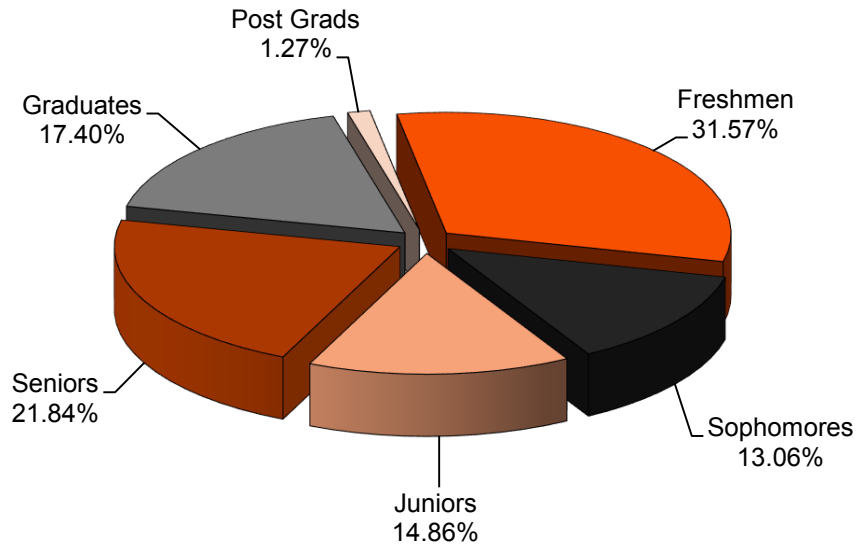

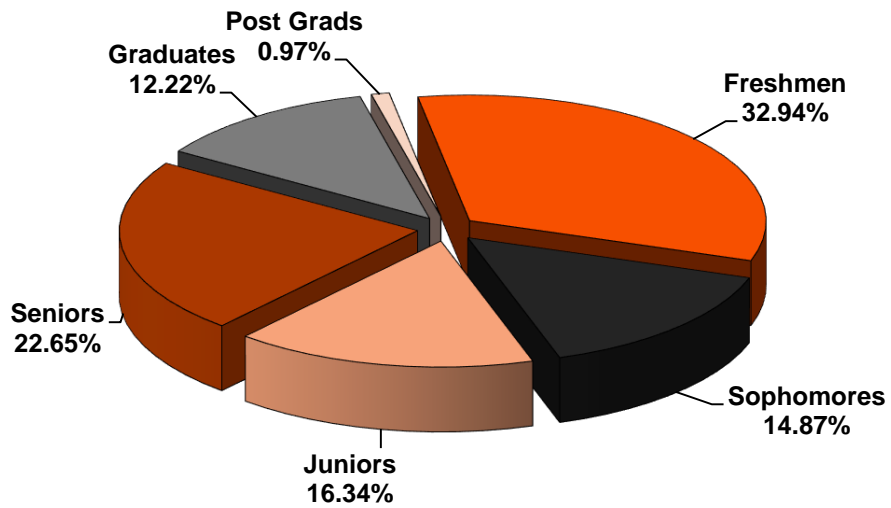


Fall 2016 Headcount and FTE Enrollment

Fall 2016 Headcount Enrollment by Classification

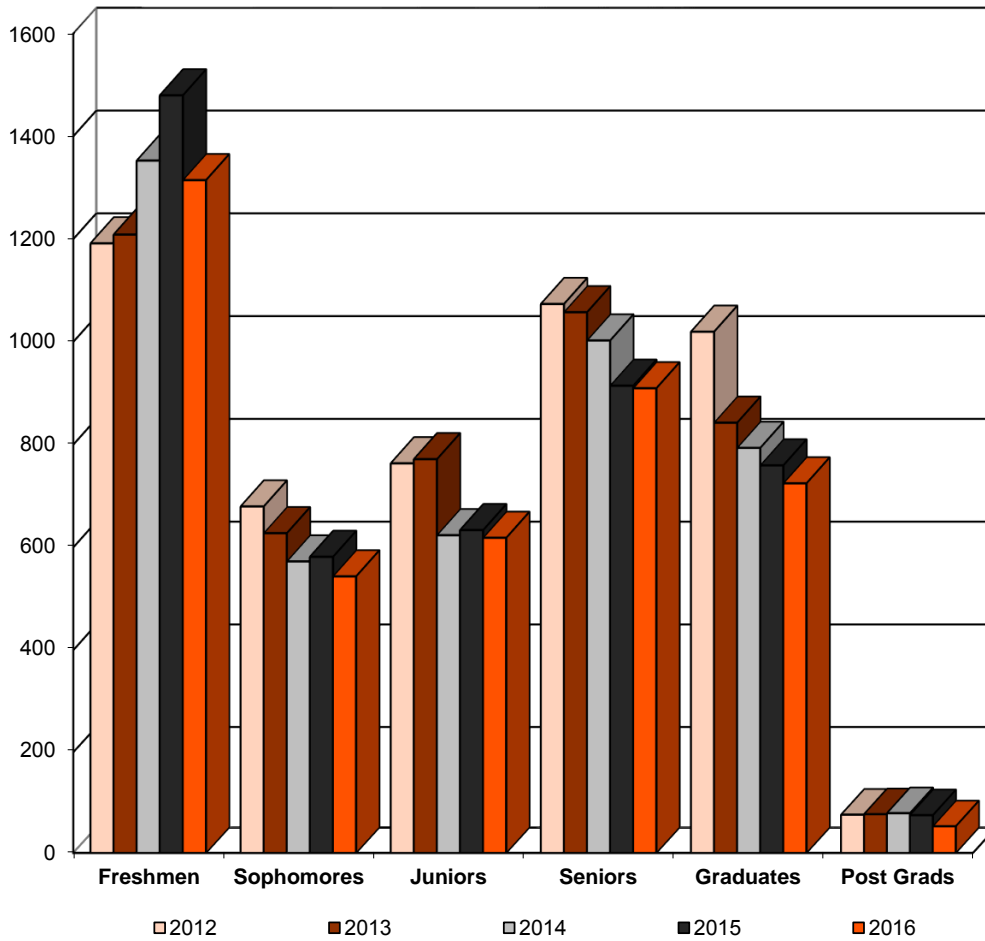


Fall 2016 FTE Enrollment by Classification

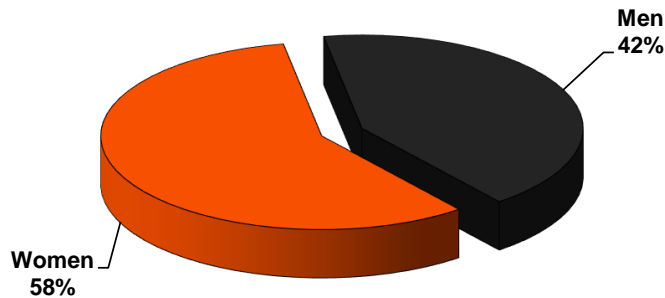

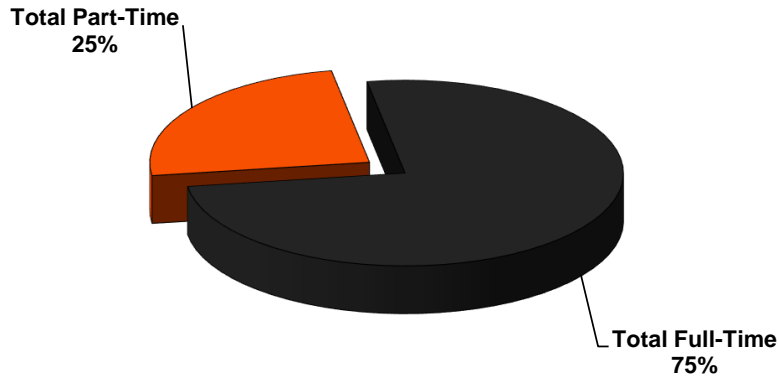

Fall 2016 Full-Time Enrollment by Sex

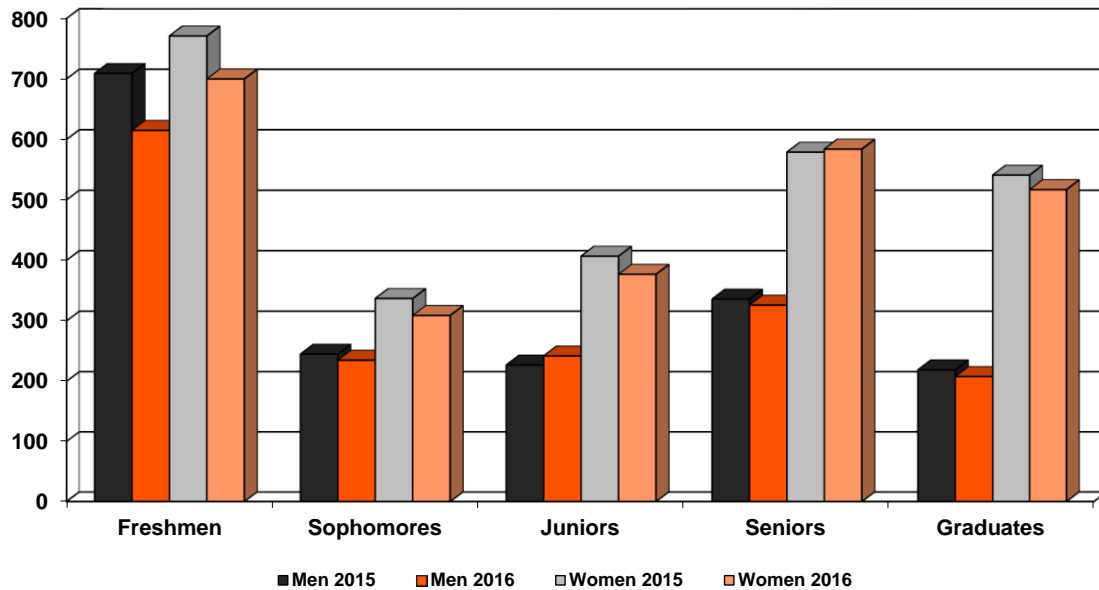


Fall 2016 Enrollment by Full-Time & Part-Time Status

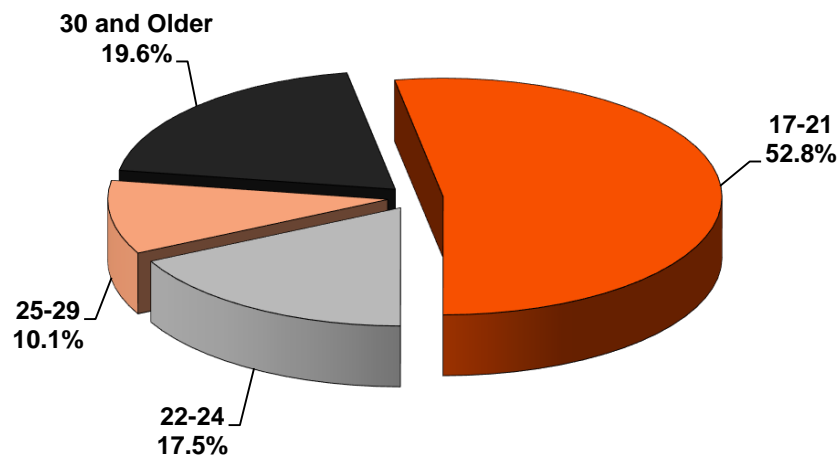

Fall 2016 Age Distribution Analysis of ECU Students



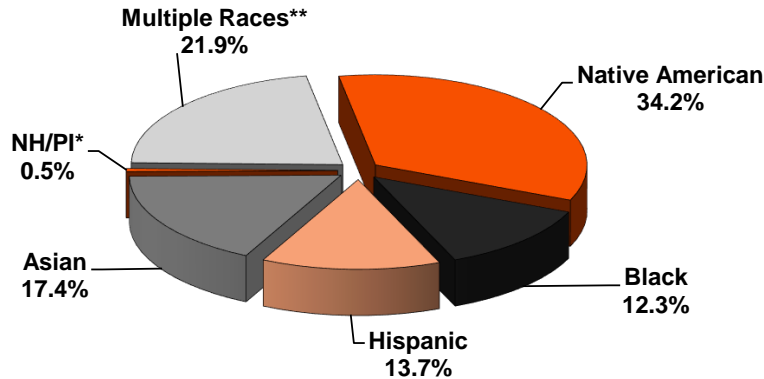

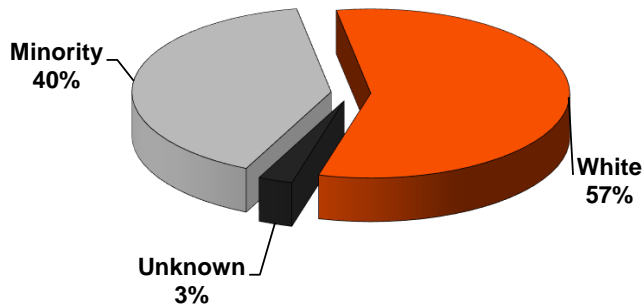

Minority and White Enrollment



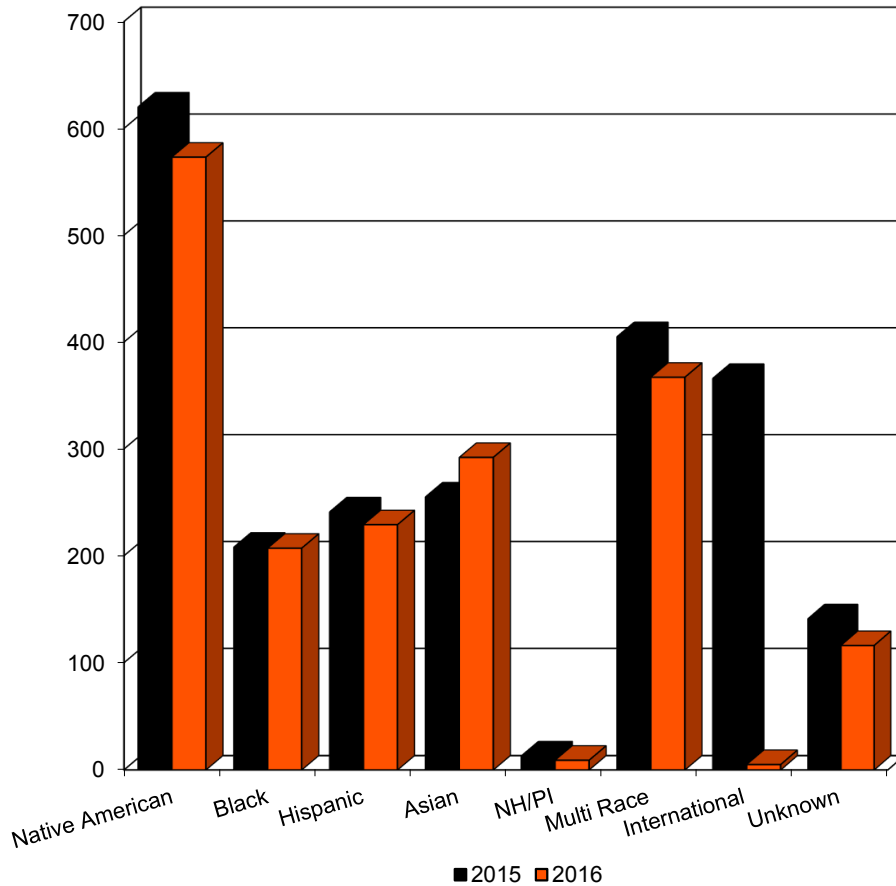

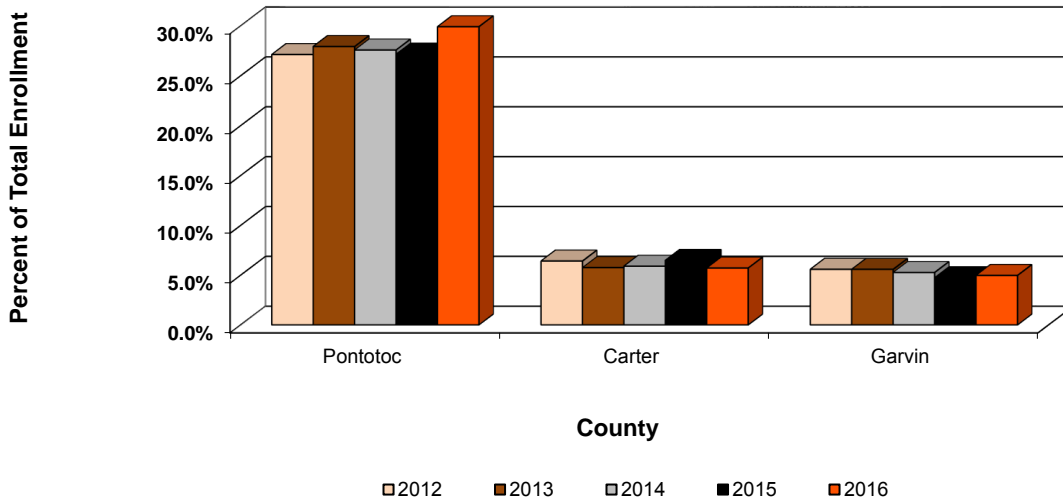

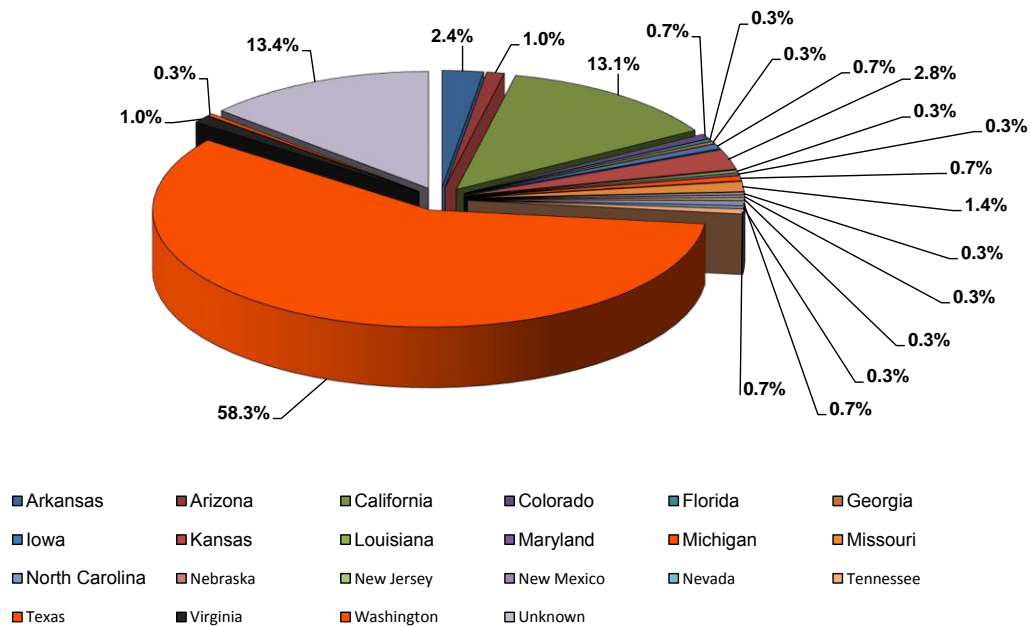

Distribution of Out-of-State Enrollment

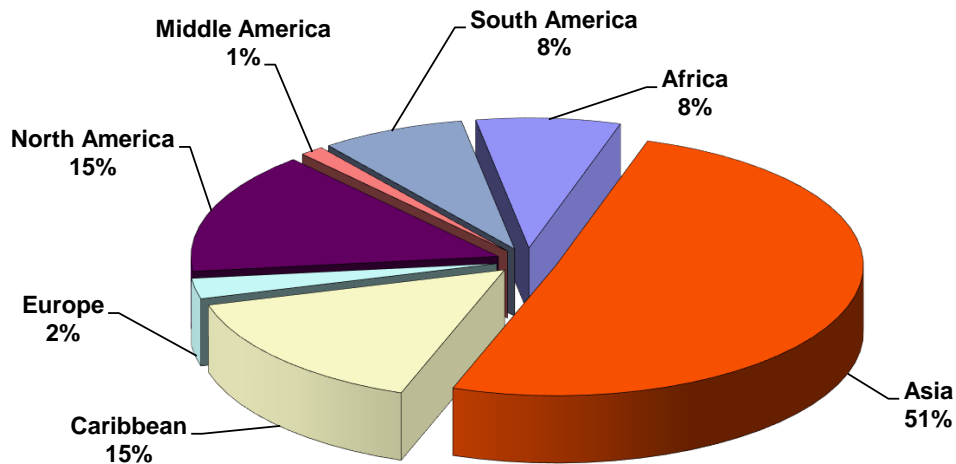

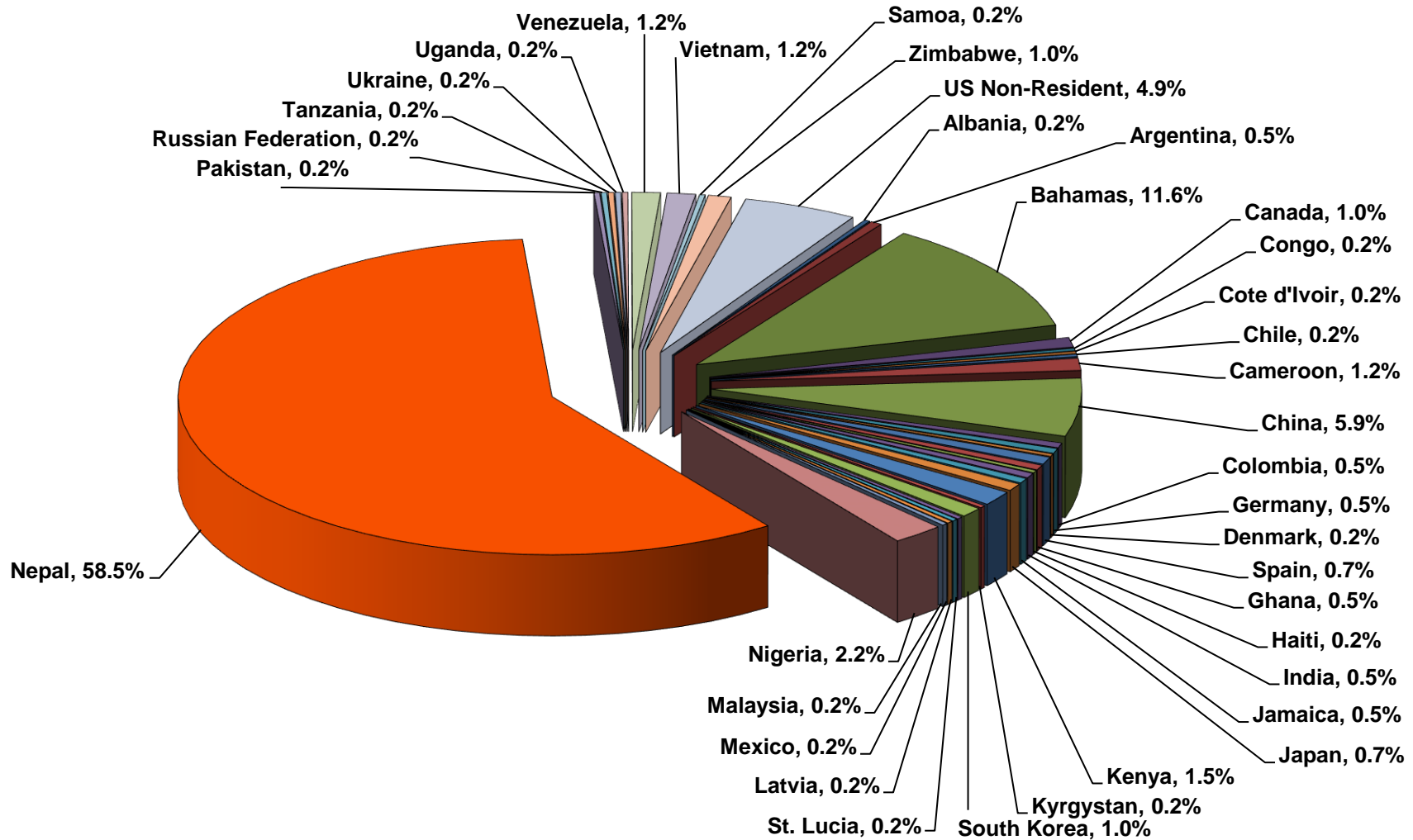
