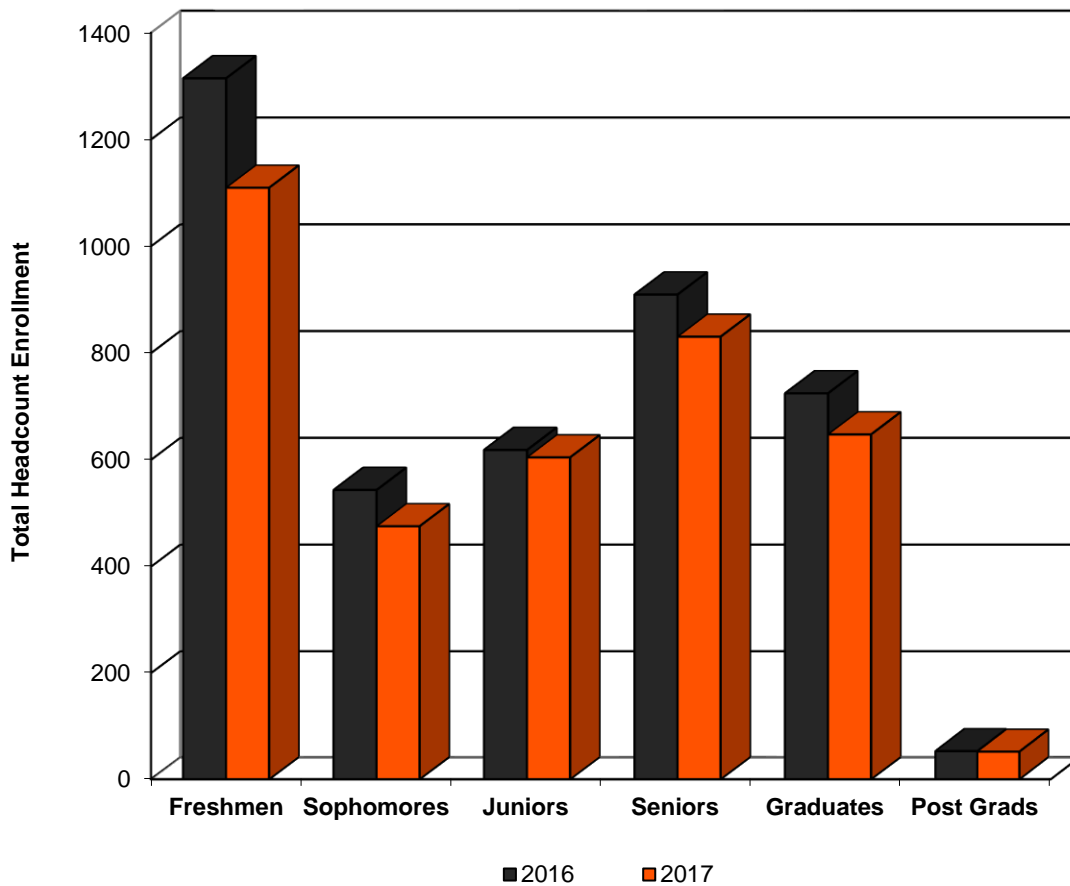
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Fall 2017 Headcount Enrollment Compared to Fall 2016

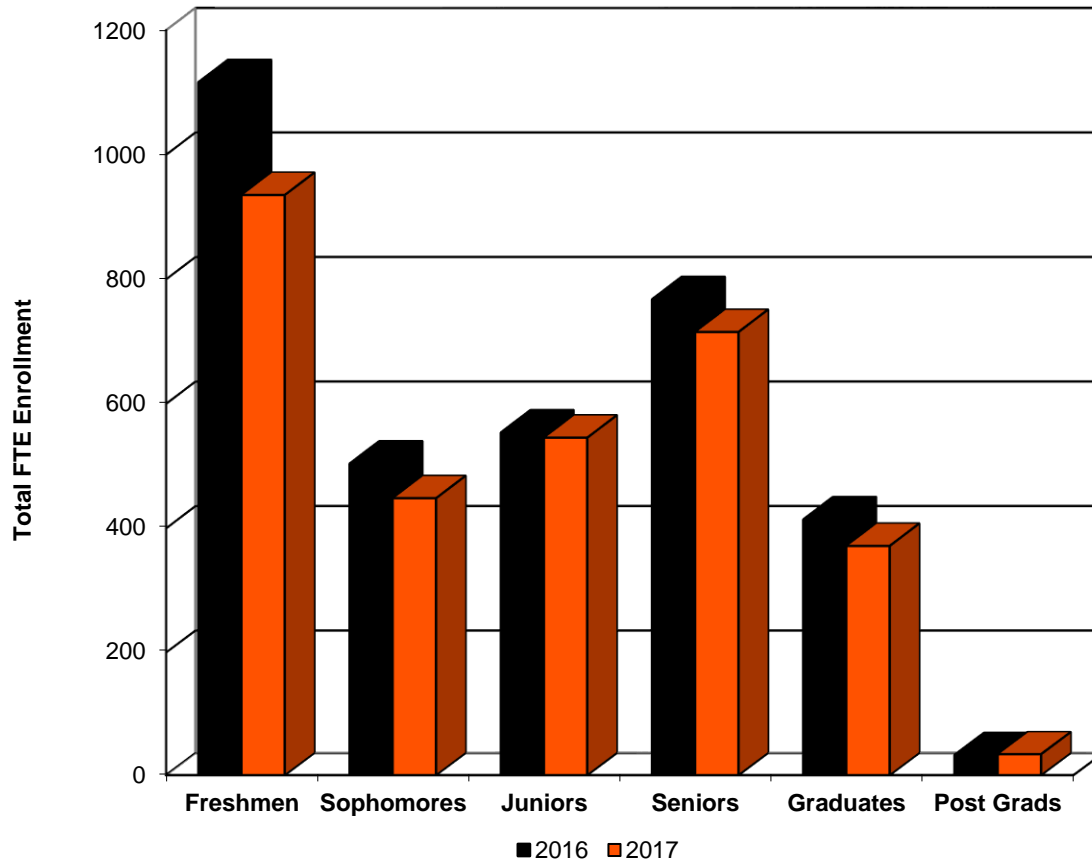

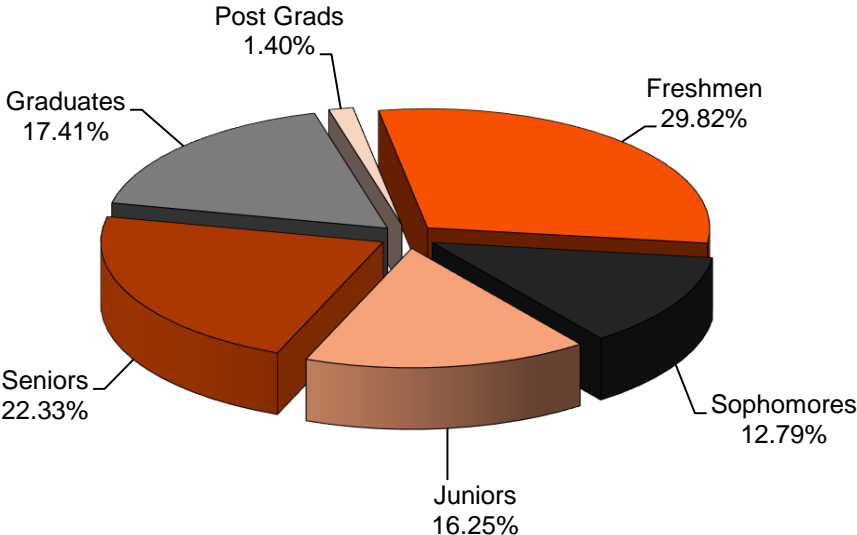

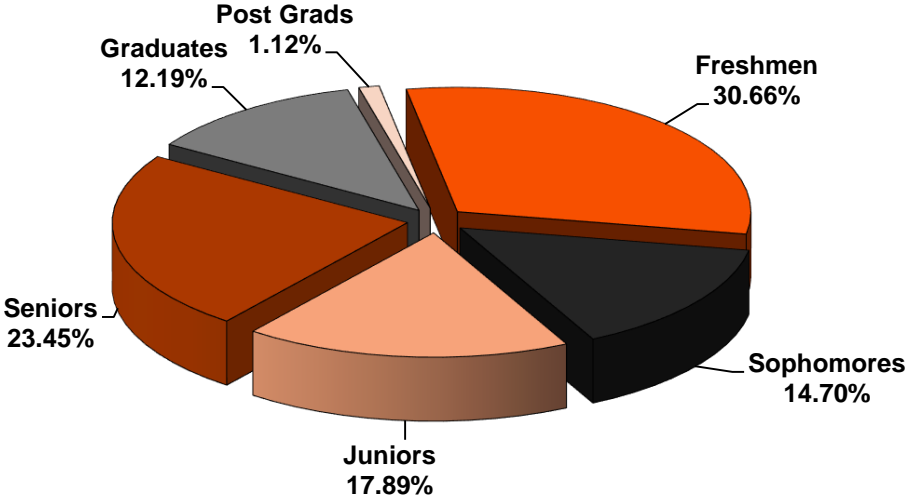


Fall 2017 Headcount and FTE Enrollment

Fall 2017 Headcount Enrollment by Classification

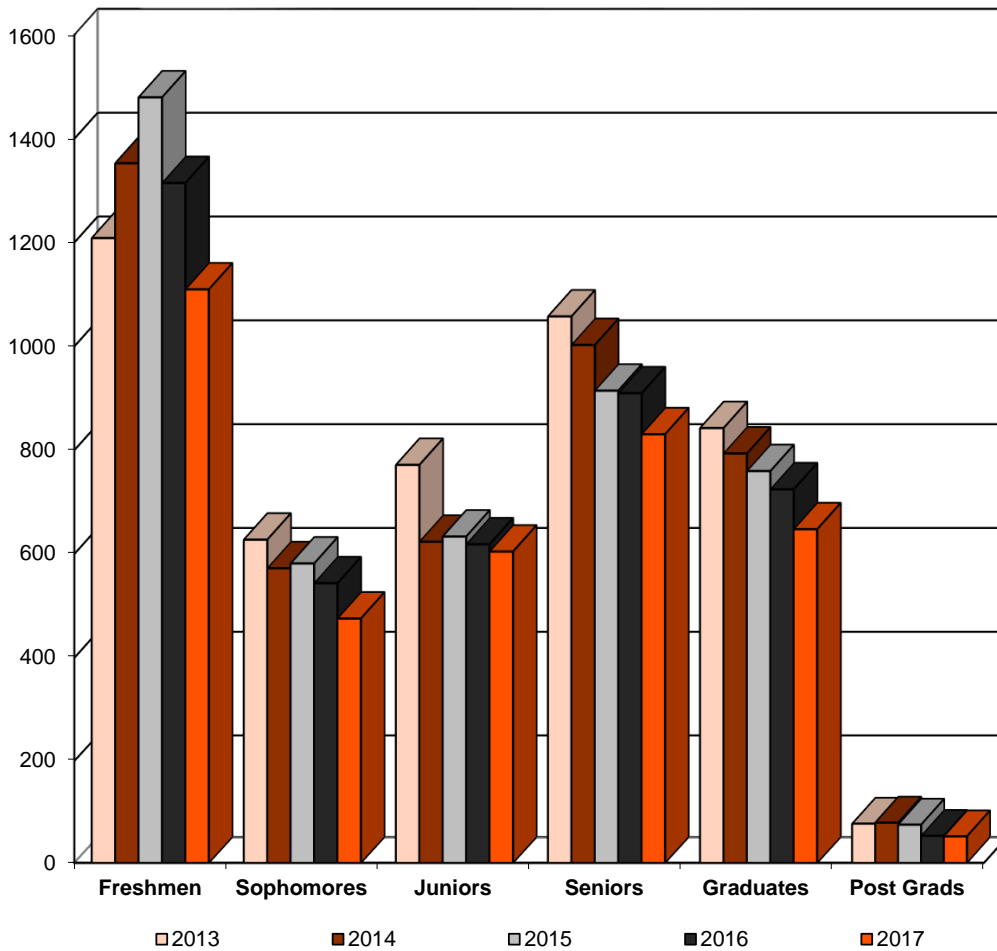


Fall 2017 FTE Enrollment by Classification

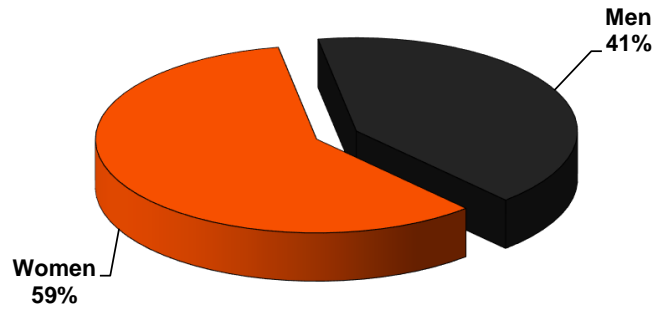

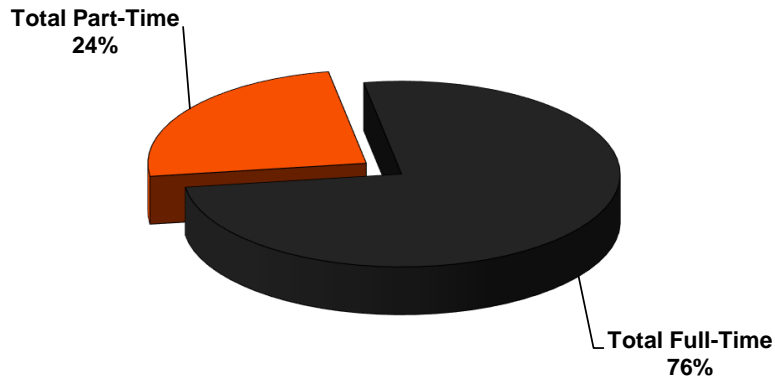

Fall 2017 Full-Time Enrollment by Sex

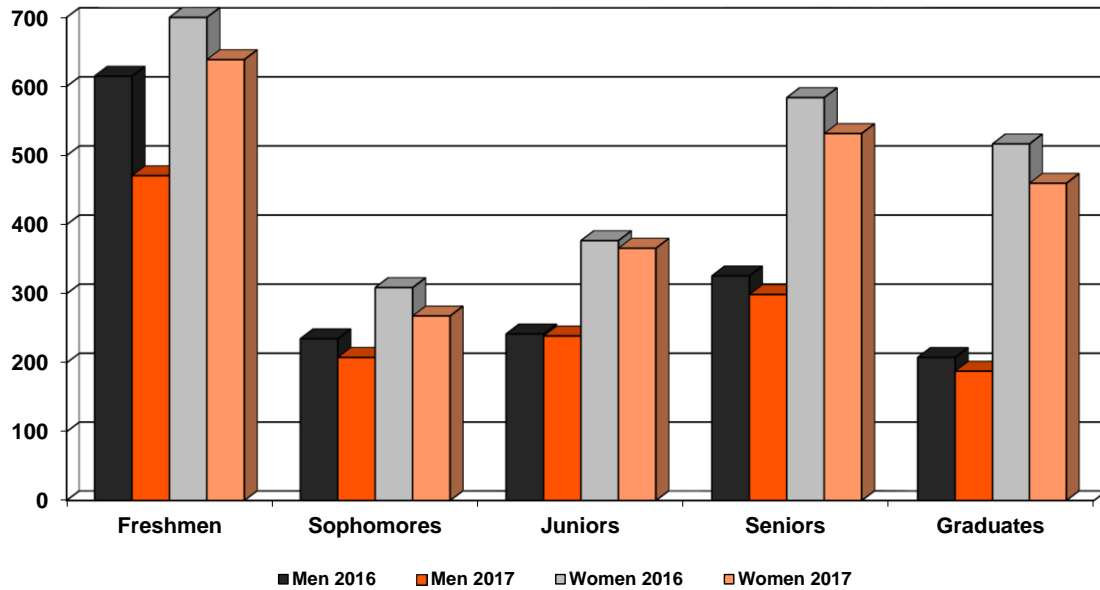


Fall 2017 Enrollment by Full-Time & Part-Time Status

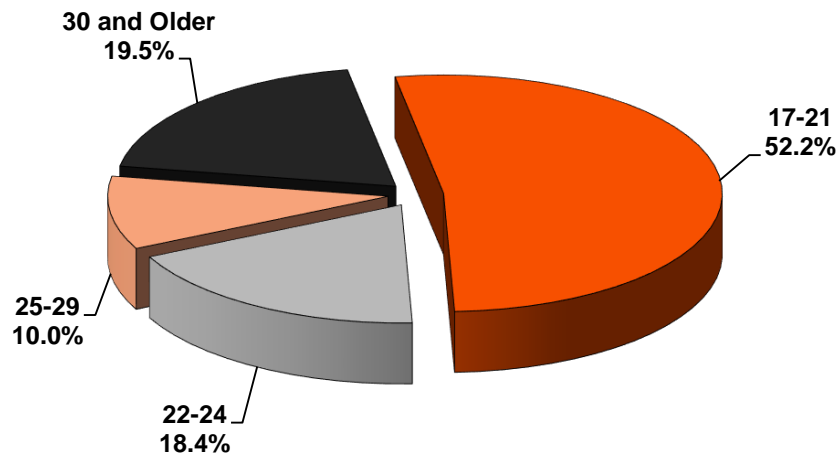

Fall 2017 Age Distribution Analysis of ECU Students



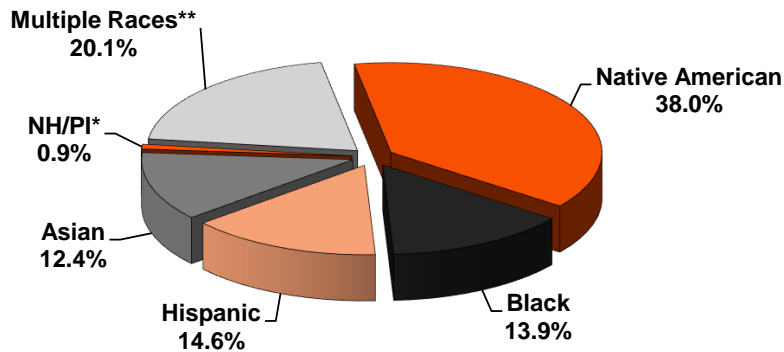

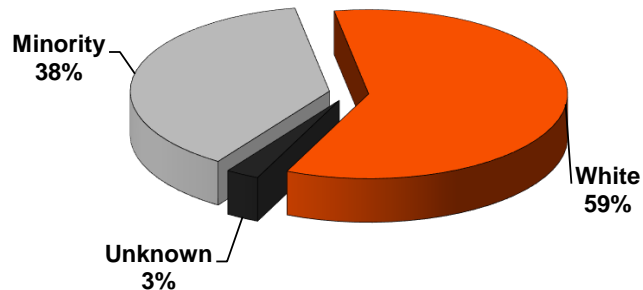

Minority and White Enrollment



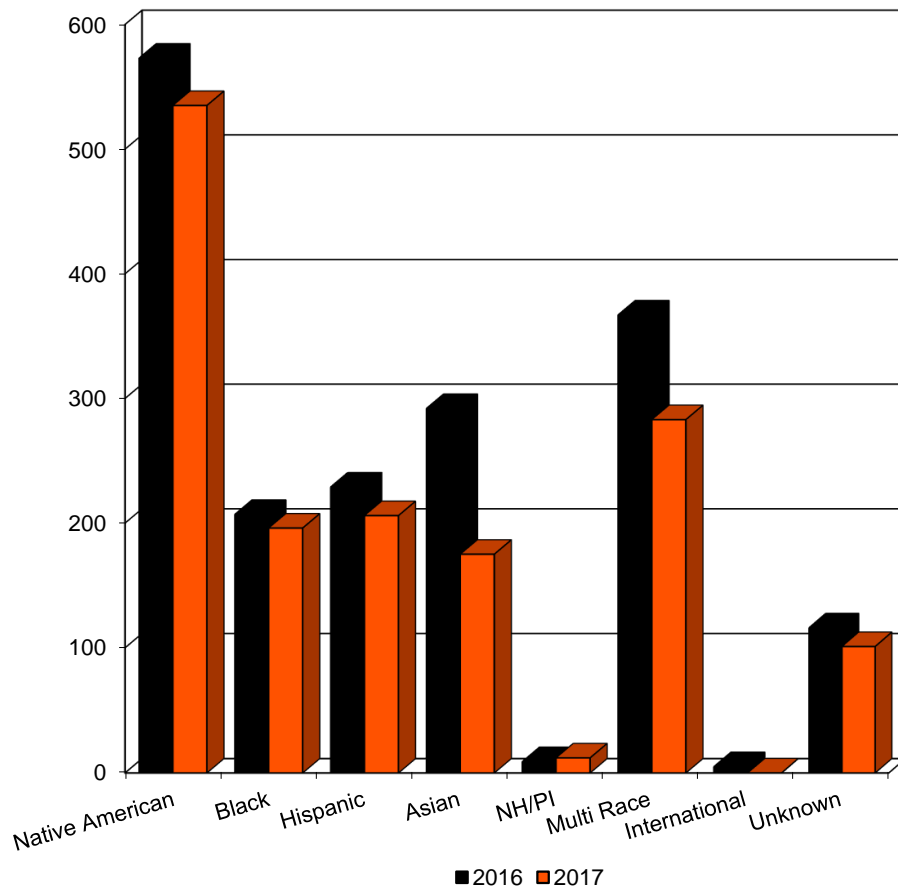

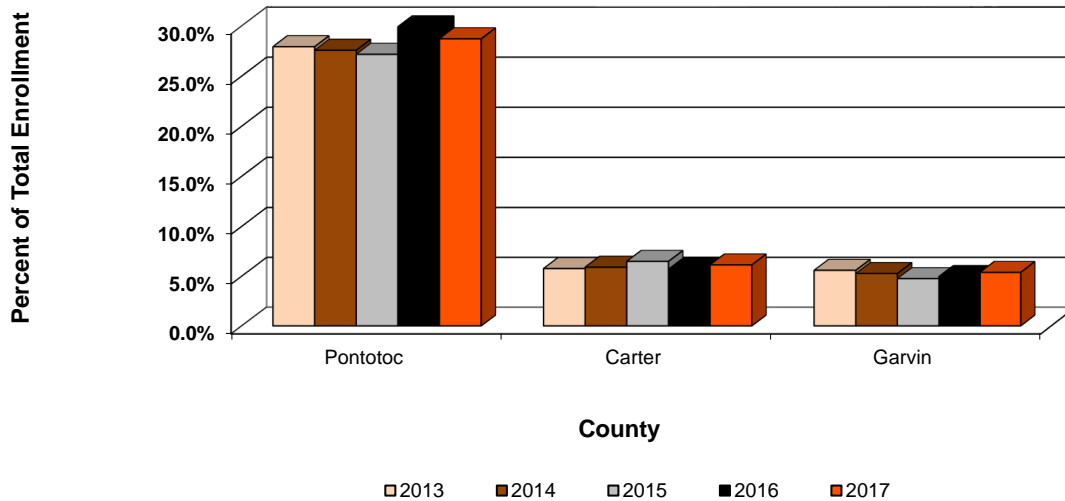

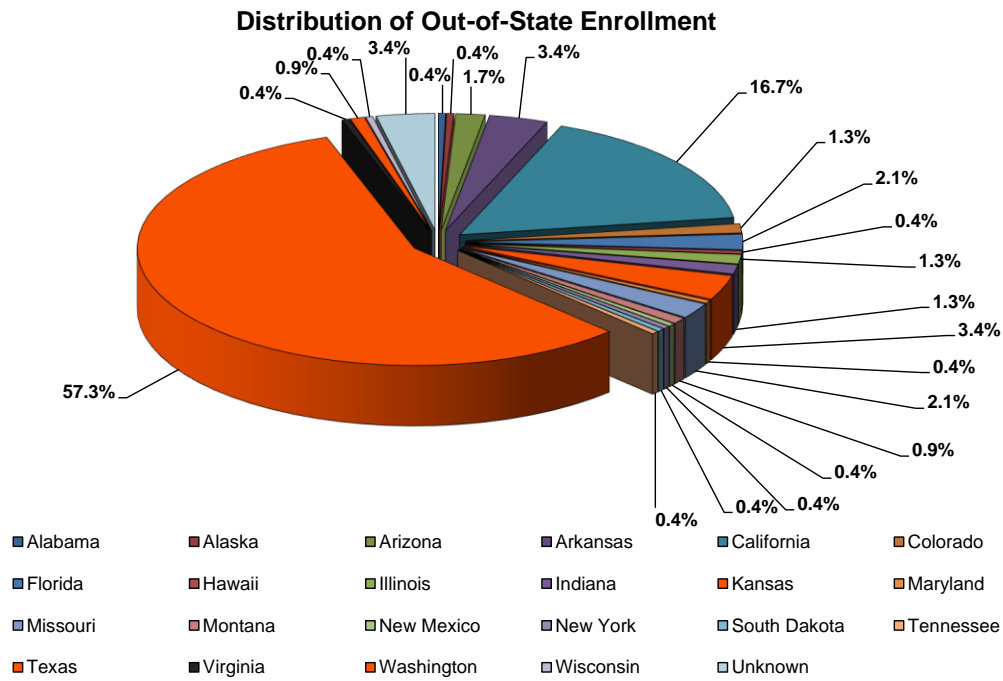

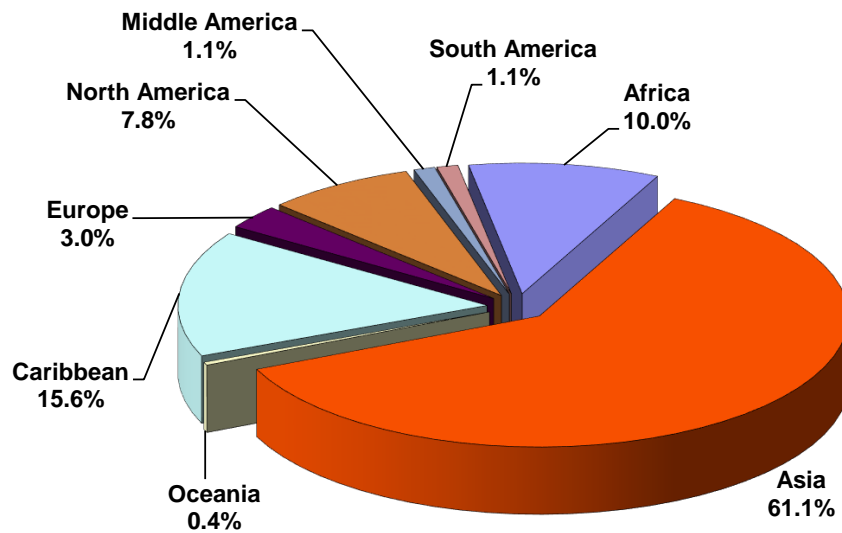

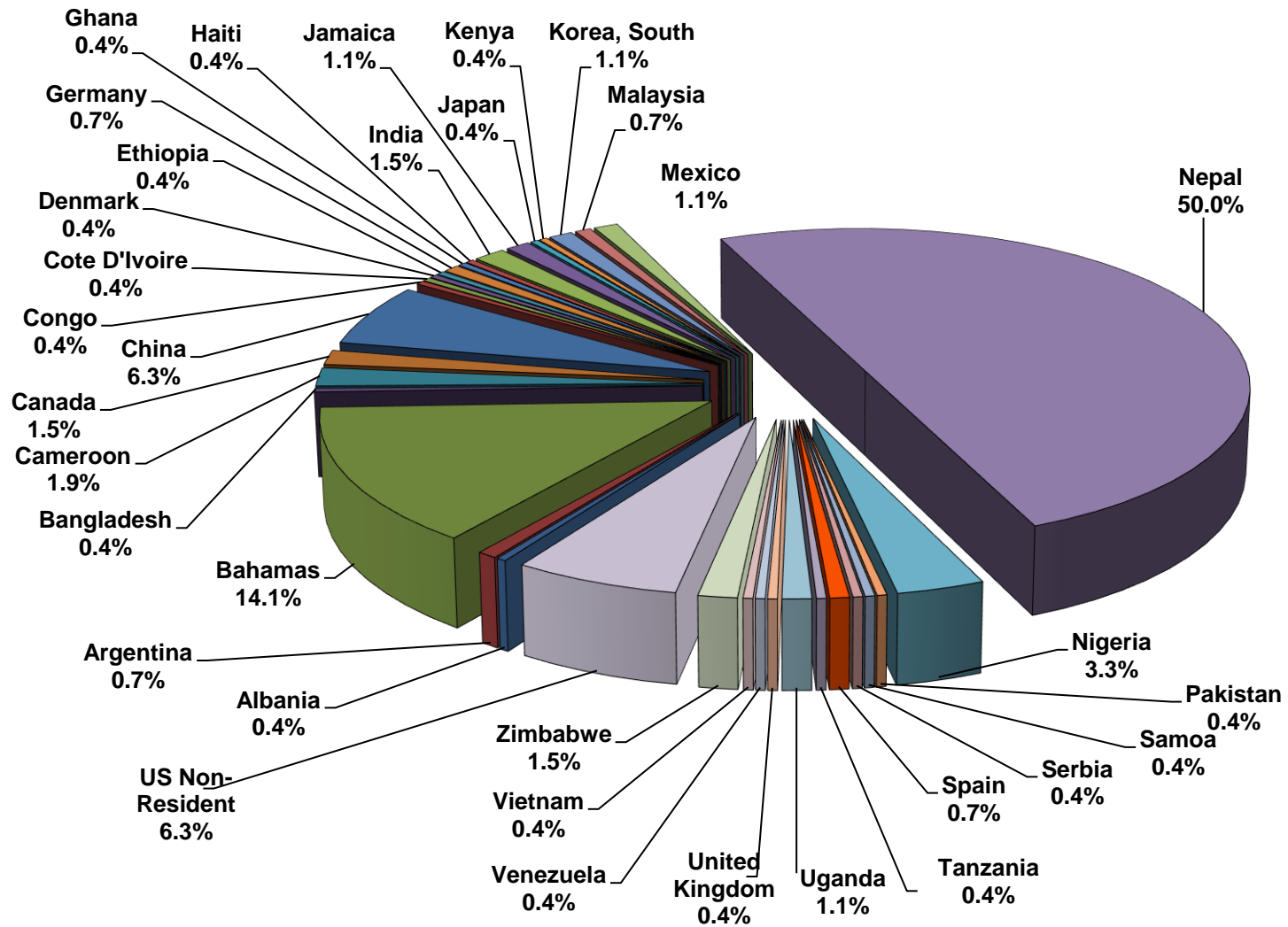
