Analysis of LO1

Overall mean for the two assessed courses is 2.96 (MUS 2533: 2.82 and PSYCH 1113: 3.09); **overall mean for the AY is 2.96**. Standard of 3.0 was not met overall, but was very close. Items of note:

- n=100
- The 2021-2022 AY overall mean of 2.96 is a significant increase over the previous two years (2019-20: 2.67; 2020-21: 2.89)
- Met or exceeded overall standard score (3.00) on Organization criterion for second year and Content criterion for first year
- Of the two assessed courses
 - MUS 2533 overall mean score (2.82) was a significant decrease from last year's mean (2.92)
 - Lowest overall mean of all assessed courses this year, but is still a good score
 - Assessors like the assignment but struggle to see much original work due to the brevity of an infographic
 - PSYCH 1113 overall mean score (3.09) exceeded the standard and is significantly higher than last year's mean (2.99)
 - Highest overall mean of all assessed courses this year
 - Of the 5 criteria assessed, three had scores over 3.00 (Organization: 3.19; Sources/Evidence: 3.05; Content: 3.32), the other two criteria missed the standard by 0.05 (Format/Delivery) and 0.03 (Language)

Analysis of LO2

Overall mean for the six courses assessed is 2.98; **overall mean for the AY is 2.88**. Standard of 3.0 was not met overall. Items of note:

- n=100
- The 2021-2022 AY overall mean of 2.88 shows a significant decrease from last year's 2.98
 - This is due to year-to-year decreases in overall means for 4 of the 9 courses (ECON 2003, HIST 2483, HIST 2493, PS 1113)
- One course which was scheduled to be assessed was not offered this spring (HUM 2633)
- Of the six assessed courses
 - BIOL 1114 overall mean score (3.84) was a slightly significant increase over last year's mean (3.78)
 - ECON 2003 overall mean score (2.93) was a significant decrease from last year's mean (3.19)
 - FIN 1113 overall mean score (2.81) was relatively consistent with last year's mean (2.83)
 - HIST 2483 overall mean score (2.44) was a significant decrease from last year's mean (2.74)
 - HIST 2493 overall mean score (2.86) was a significant decrease from last year's mean (3.04)
 - MATH 1513 overall mean score (3.00) was a slightly significant increase over last year's mean (2.92)
 - Most likely reason: Of the two courses that showed increases this year, one uses data from an online study guide with multiple choice questions and the other has students solving and explaining variations of an algebra problem, so neither one requires much writing. The assignments from the other courses use essay prompts – which have not changed from last year to this year – so it appears we have incoming students with less writing skills than prior years (which is not surprising coming out of the covid years). While the LO is over Intellectual Skills, if students cannot write well, they are less able to show their intellectual skills due to lack of communication. *This does not mean we have no control over this problem, it just means we need to focus more on teaching students to write.*

Analysis of LO3

Overall mean for the one assessed course (ENG 1213) is 2.9; **overall mean for the AY is 2.64**. Standard of 3.0 was not met overall. Items of note:

- n=57
- The 2021-2022 AY overall mean of 2.64 is a minor decrease from last year's 2.70, but this score is holding relatively steady with overall scores in the last four years being between 2.57 and 2.70
- Of the one assessed course (ENG 1213), overall mean score (2.9) was a significant decrease from last year's mean (3.05). English/Language Gen Ed report notes that artifacts were very inconsistent so this will be addressed in their department meeting and Gen Ed Assessment Information email
- No plagiarism found

Analysis of LO4

Overall mean for the two assessed courses is 2.77; **overall mean for the AY is 2.92**. Standard of 3.0 was not met overall.

Items of note:

- n=70
- The 2021-2022 AY overall mean of 2.92 is a significant increase over the previous year and is the highest AY mean for LO4 since we began gathering data 6 years ago
- Bb did not pull data for one course which was scheduled to be assessed (ASLHR 2613); the alignments were made, not sure why the data was not pulled
- Of the two assessed courses
 - HIST 1113 overall mean score (2.77) was a significant increase over last year's mean (2.50)
 - SOC 1113 overall mean score (2.76) was a significant increase over last year's mean (2.49)
 - The assignments for these courses have not changed and both courses are fully online, so not sure exactly where the increase is coming from, unless instructors have added information about current world events to Bb shells or students themselves are now more aware of intercultural differences and how those play out on the world stage
- No plagiarism found

Analysis of Assessment Process for Spring:

- Assessed 11 courses (should have been 12)
 - Bb did not pull artifacts from 1 course (ASLHR 2613); alignment was made, not sure why this happened
- All artifacts pulled through Bb (exceptions: BIOL 1114 and ENG 1213)
- Alignment of learning outcomes with artifact assignments in Bb was finished by mid-semester (Yay!)
 - Assessment Coordinator followed-up earlier with Chairs/Gen Ed Instructors
- No plagiarism found

New Gen Ed outcomes and new assessment process will be *piloted* in the fall, *still working out the assessment details*.
