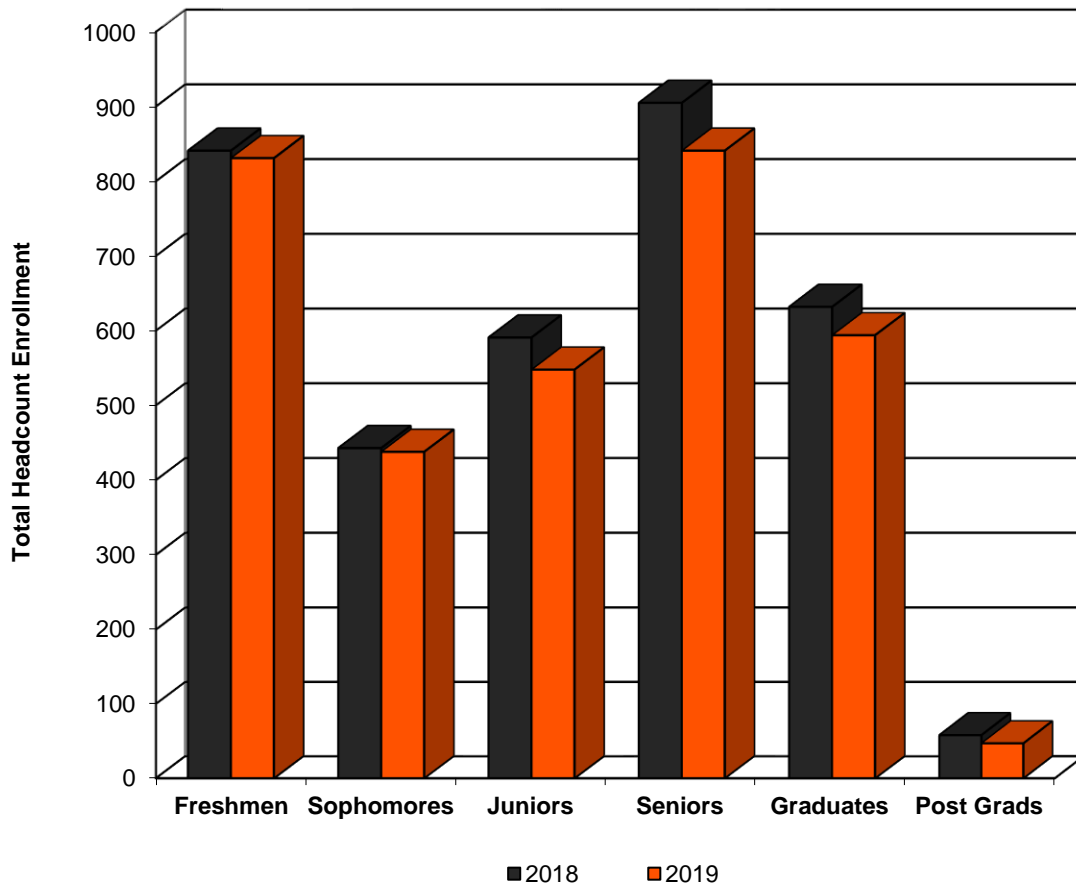

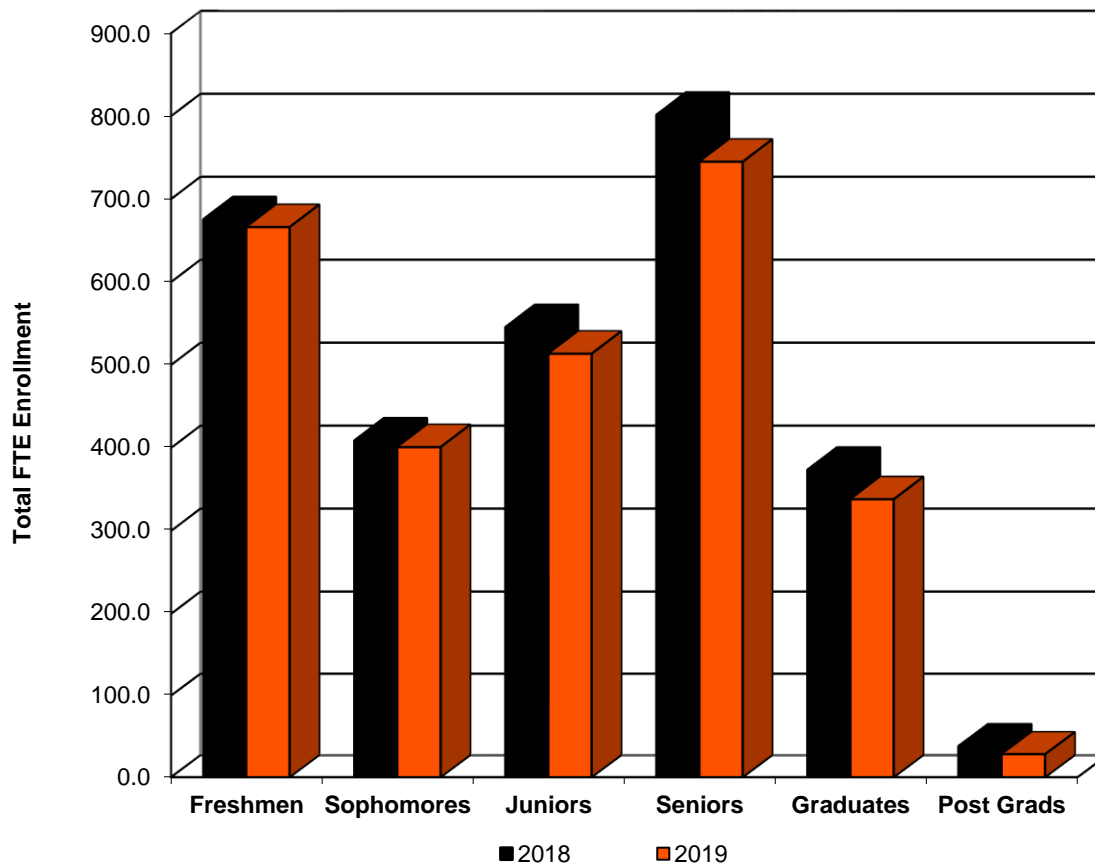

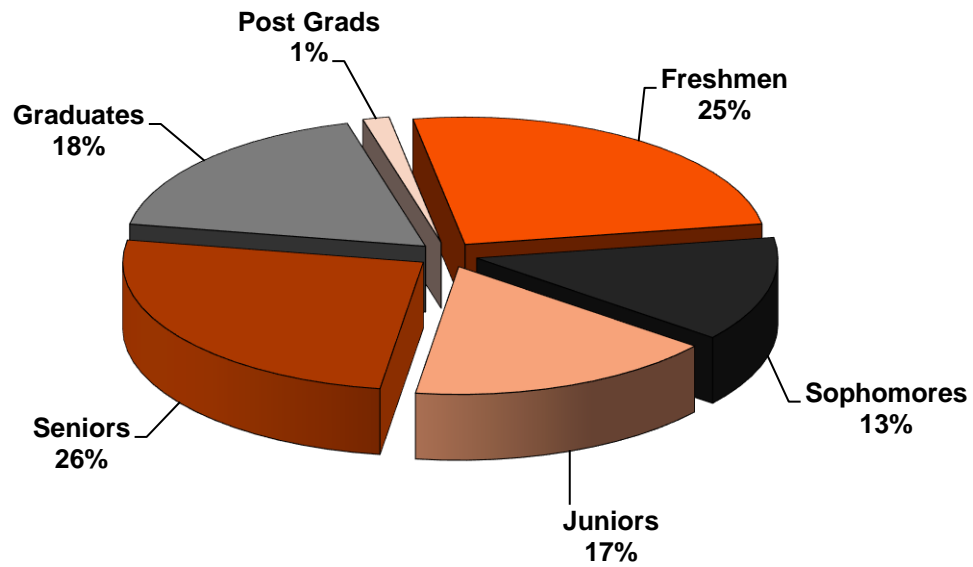

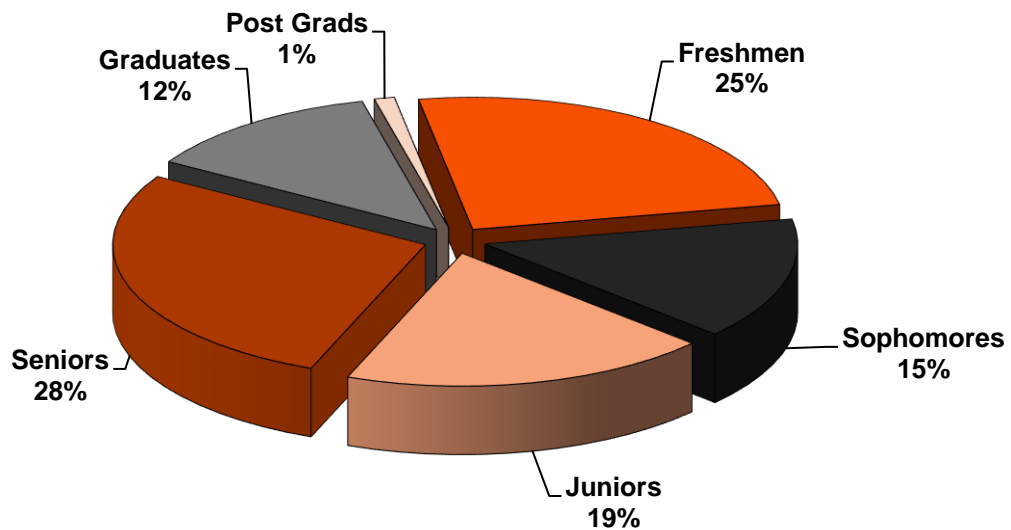


Spring 2019 Headcount and FTE Enrollment

Spring 2019 Headcount Enrollment by Classification

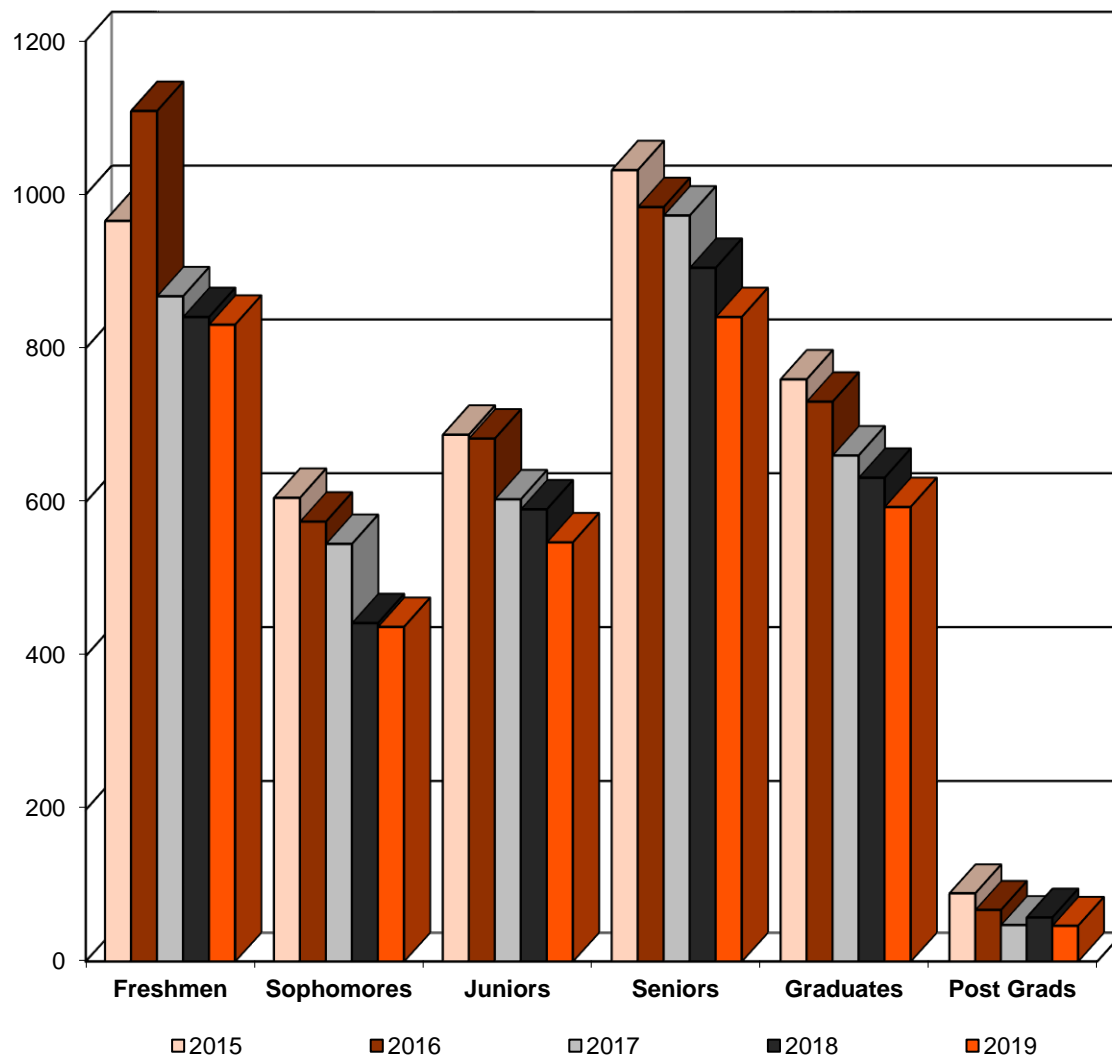


Spring 2019 FTE Enrollment by Classification

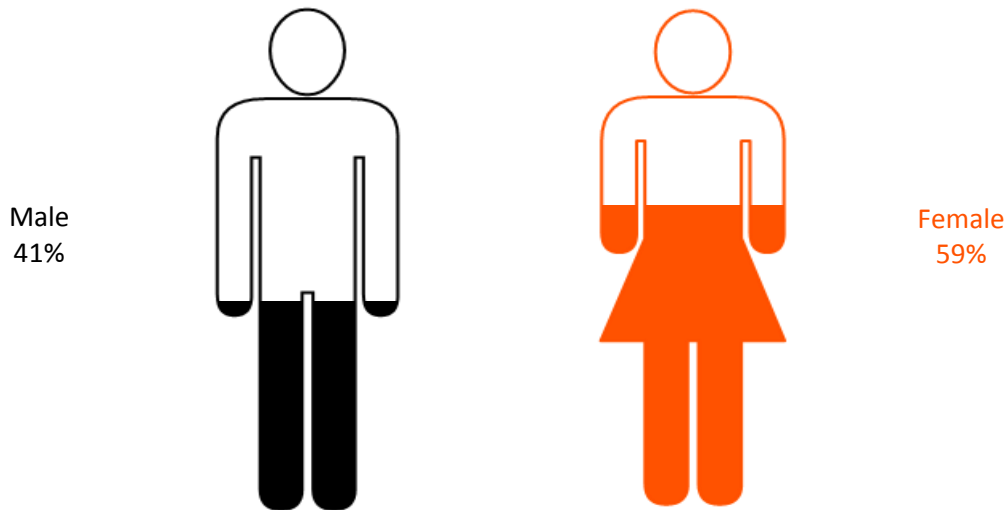

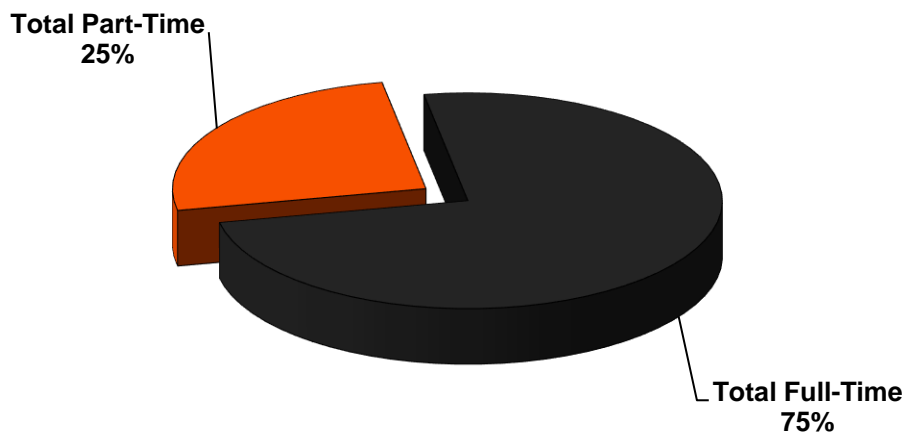

Spring 2019 Full-Time Enrollment by Sex

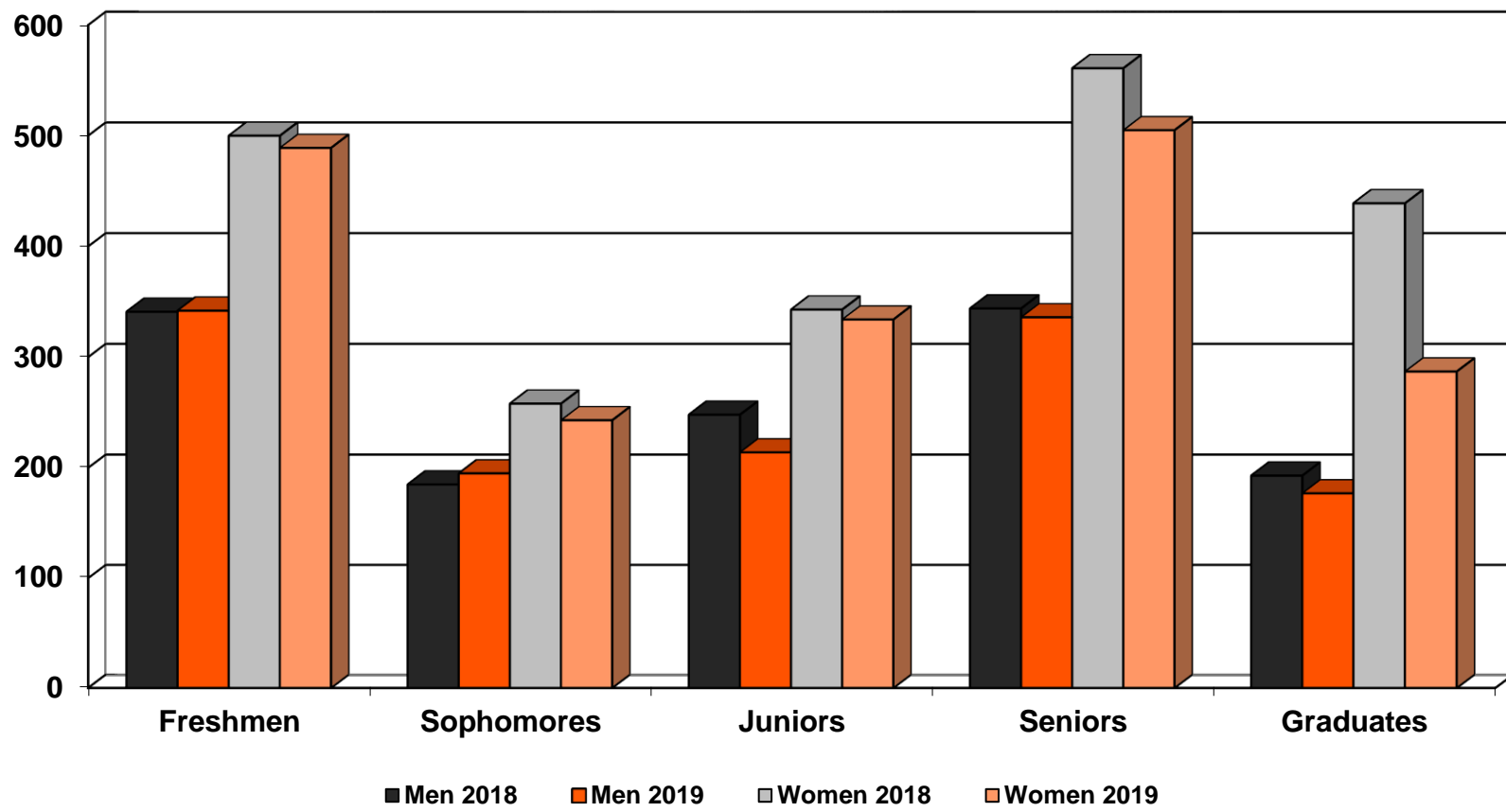


Spring 2019 Enrollment by Full-Time & Part-Time Status

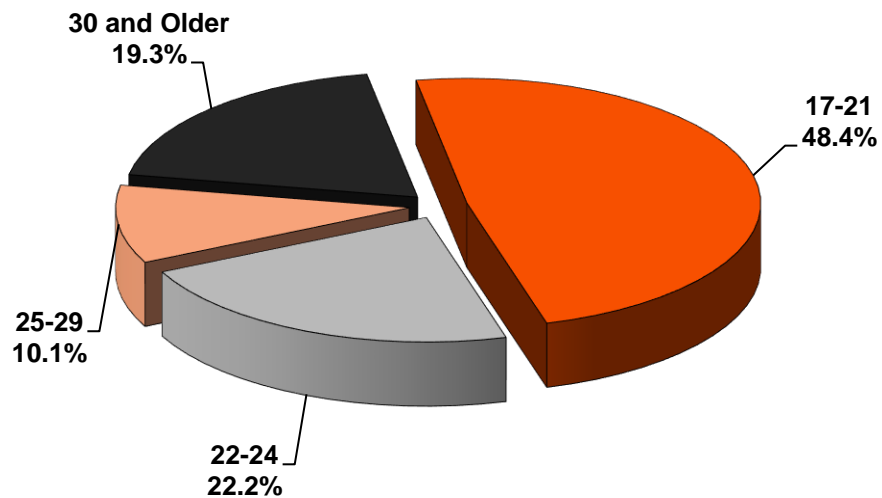

Spring 2019 Age Distribution Analysis of ECU Students



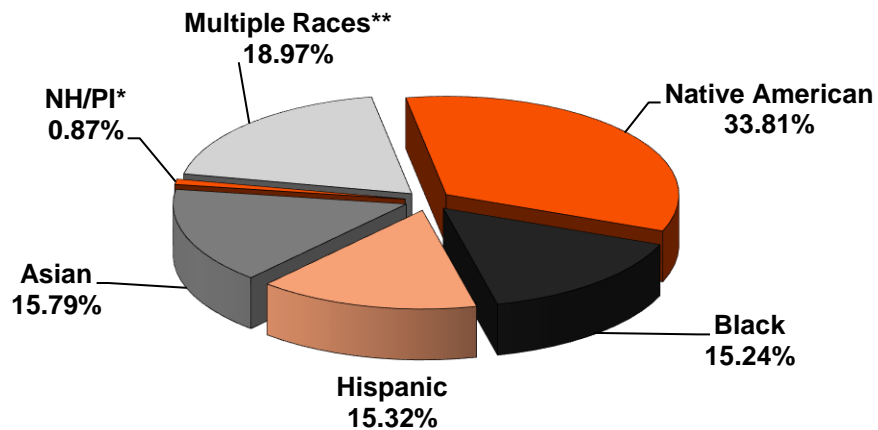

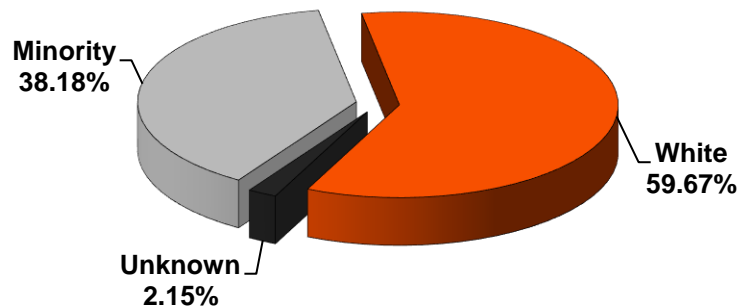

Minority and White Enrollment



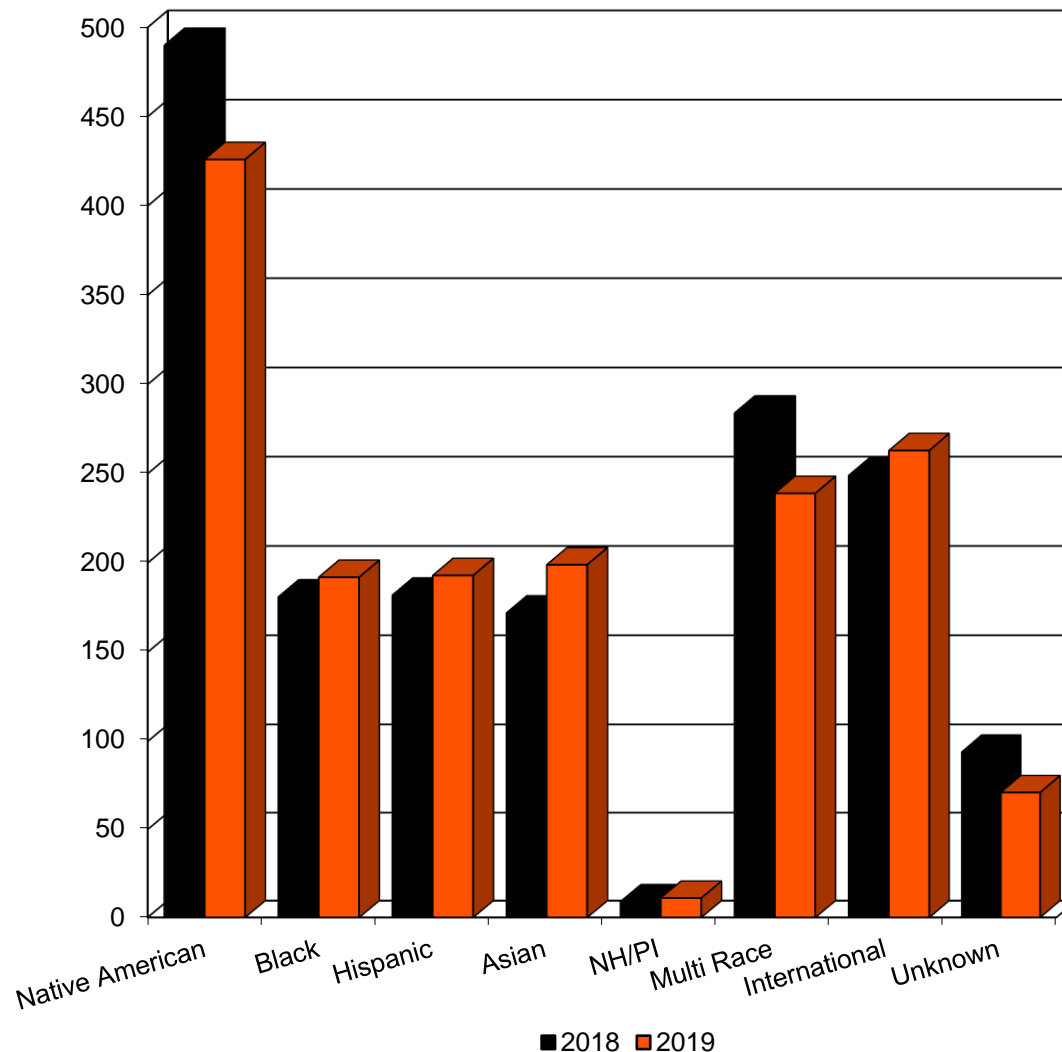

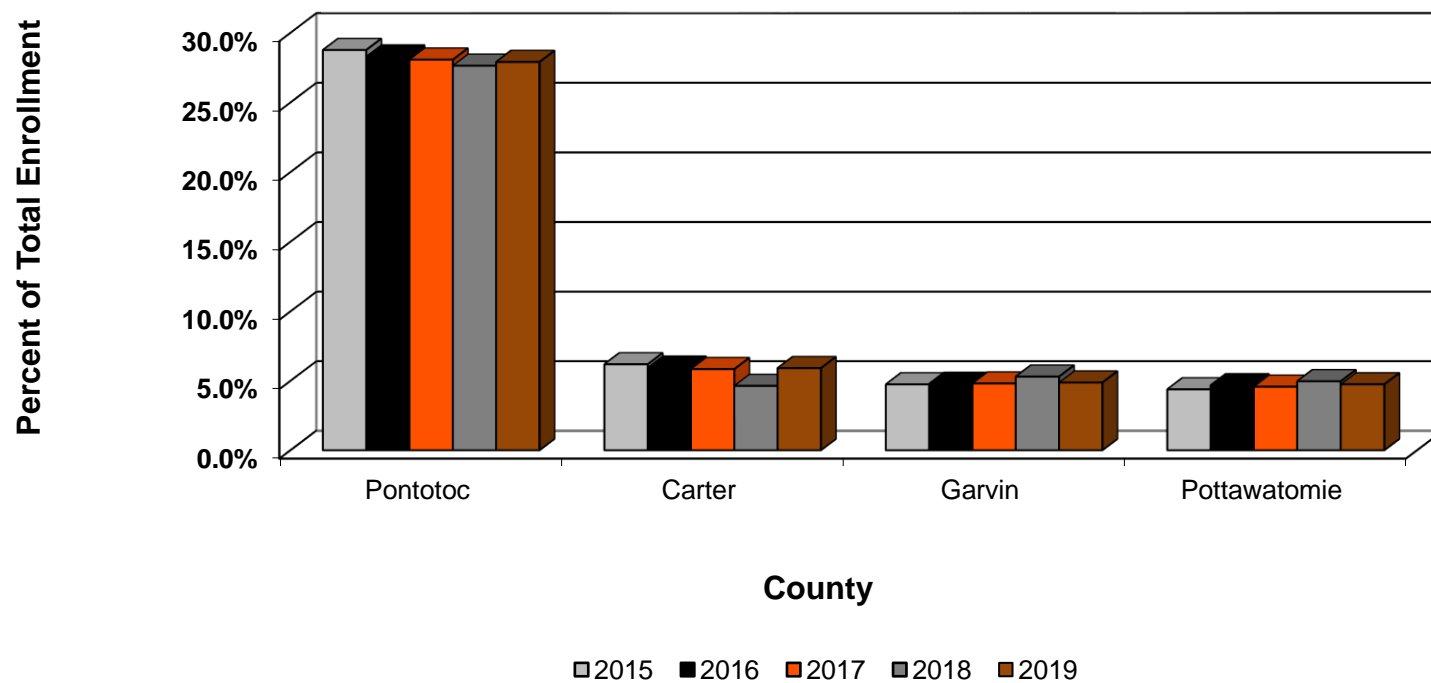

2019 Counties Accounting for an Average of Five Percent or More of Total Enrollment



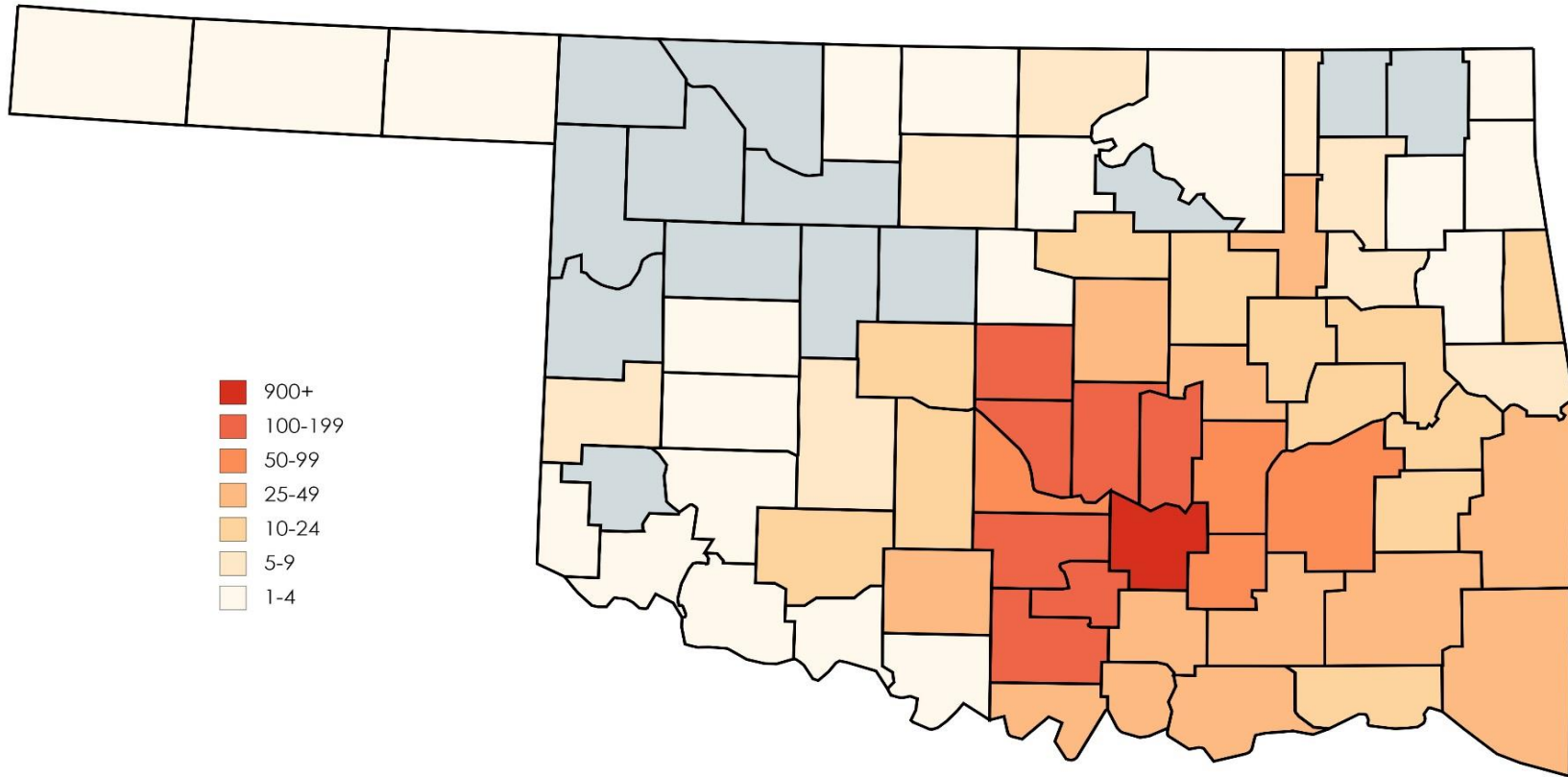

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Enrollment by County for Spring 2019



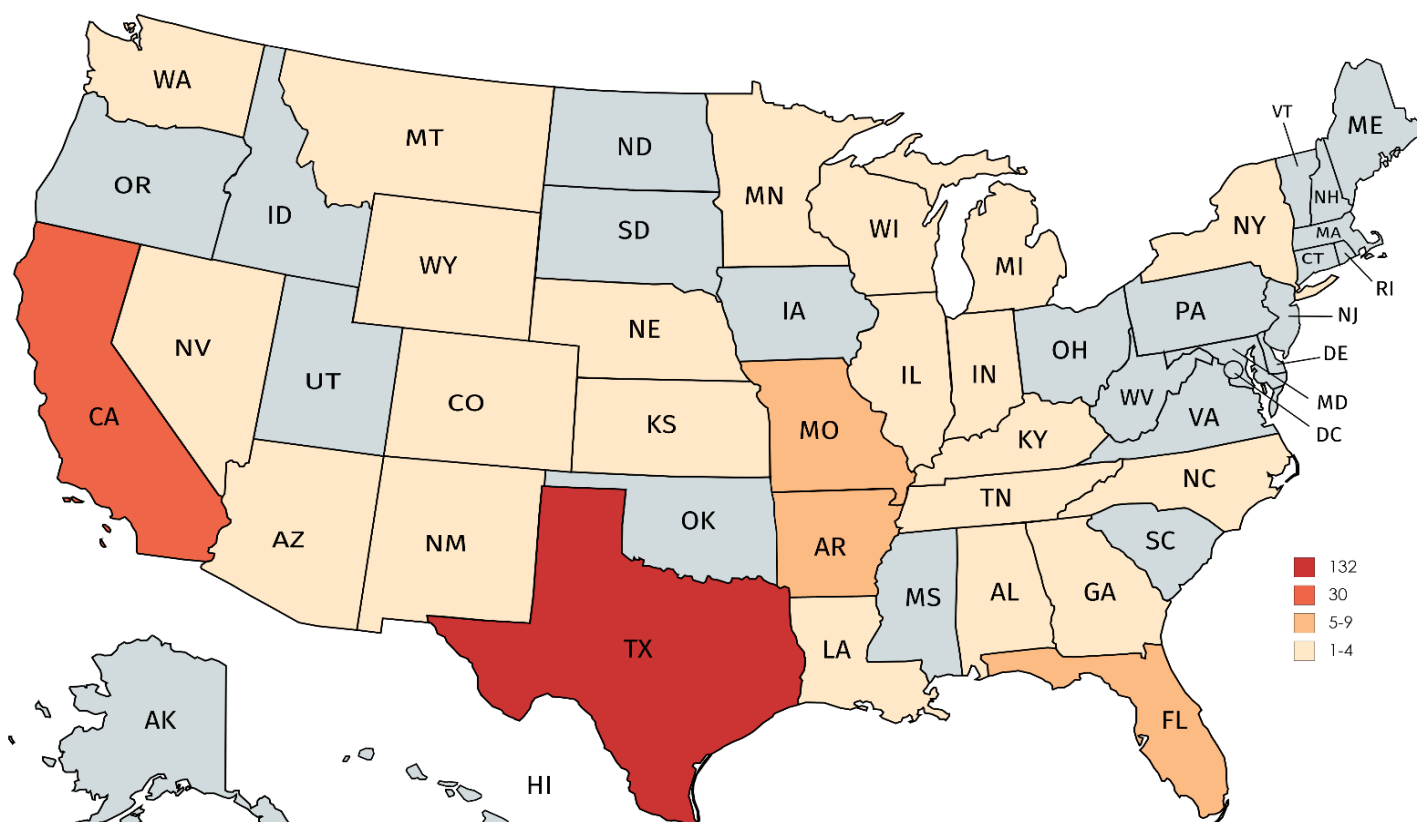

Distribution of Out-of-State Enrollment

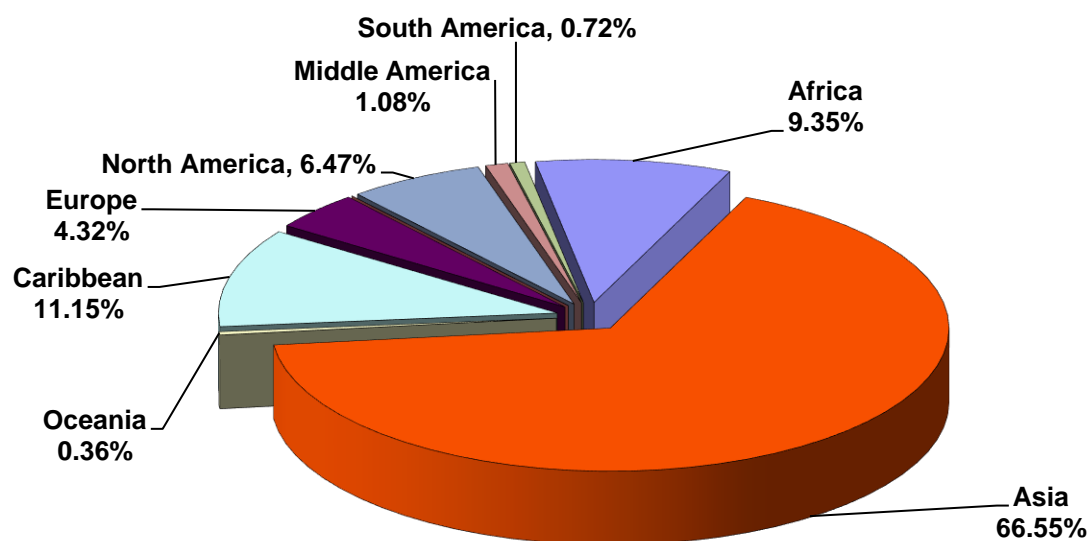
