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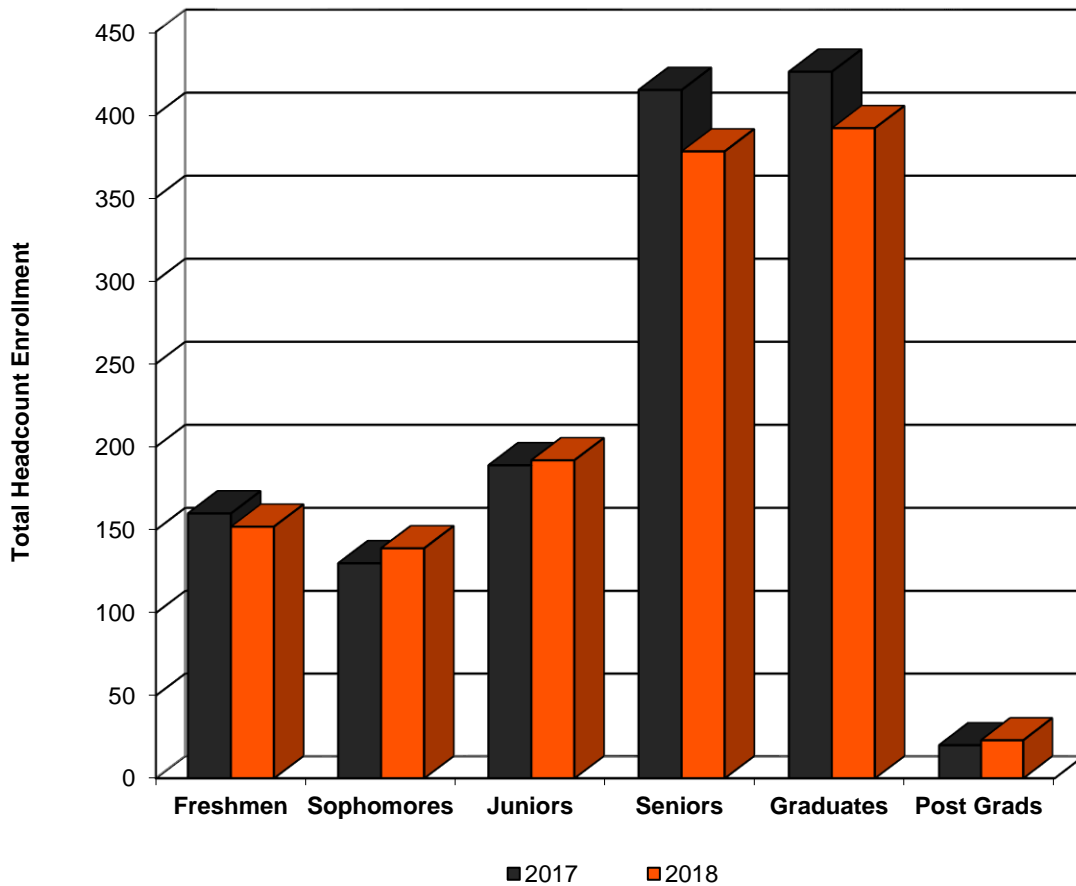

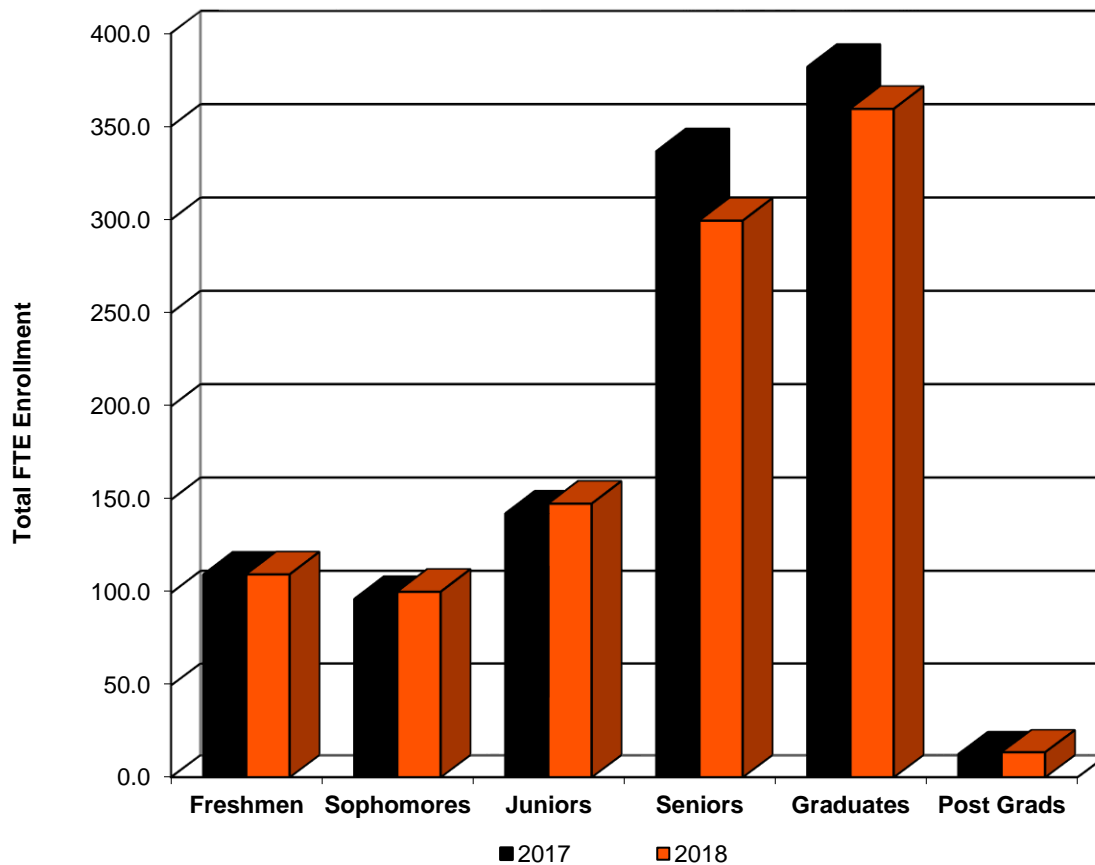

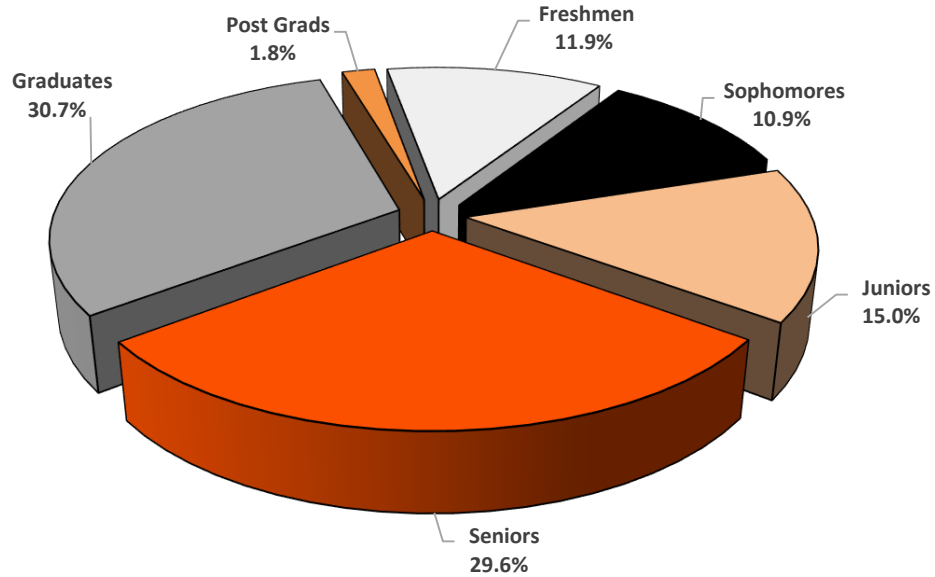

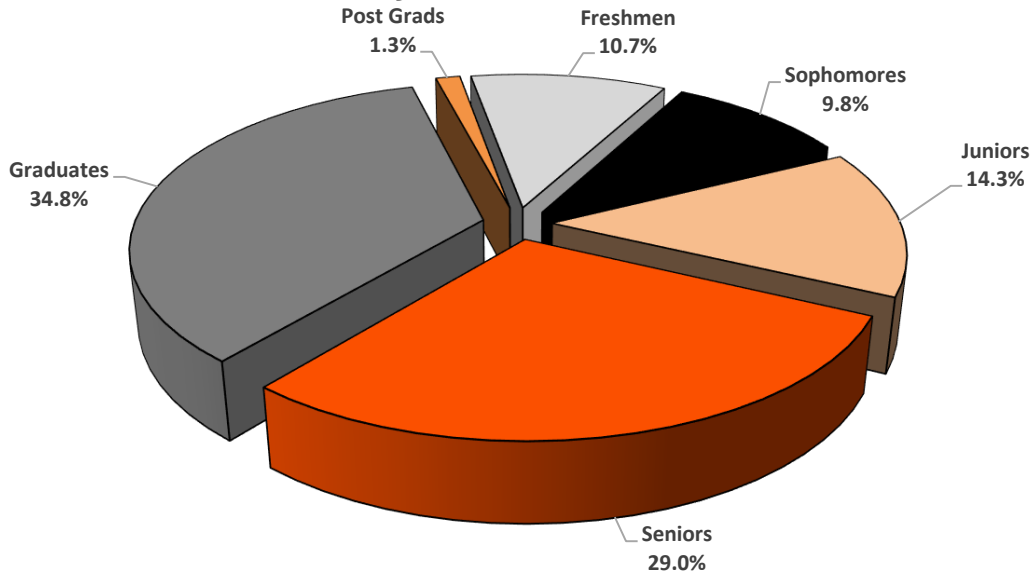


Summer 2018 Headcount and FTE Enrollment

Summer 2018 Headcount Enrollment by Classification

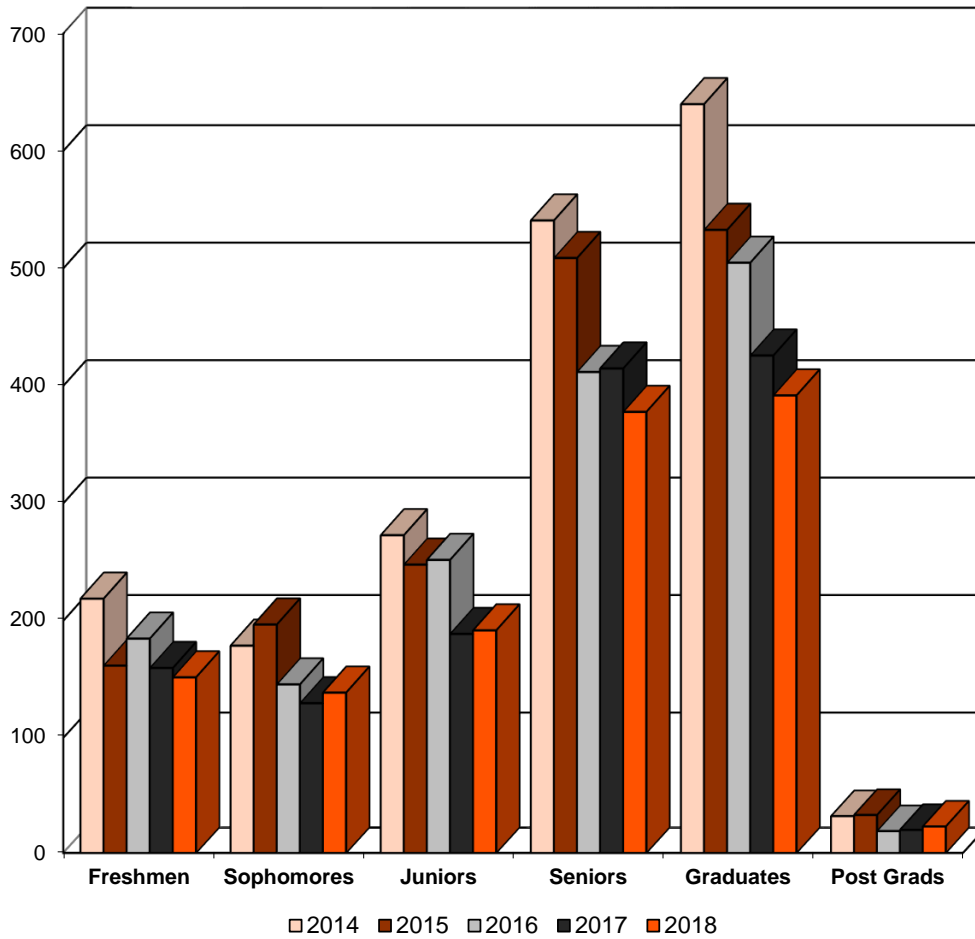


Summer 2018 FTE Enrollment by Classification

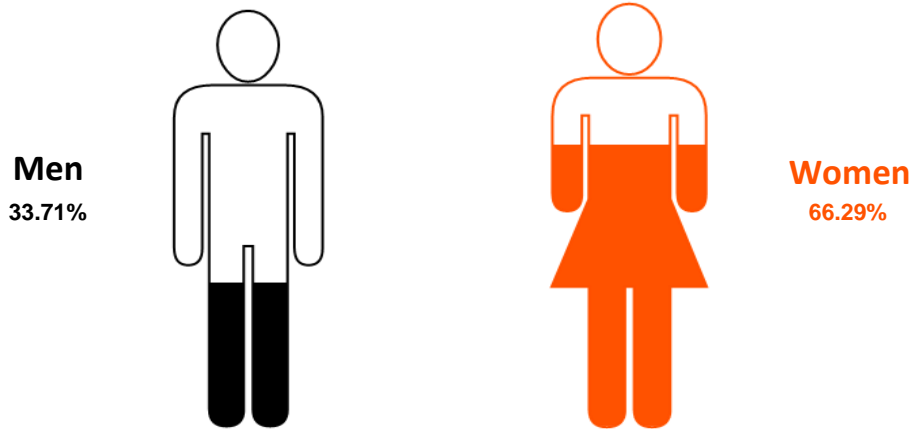

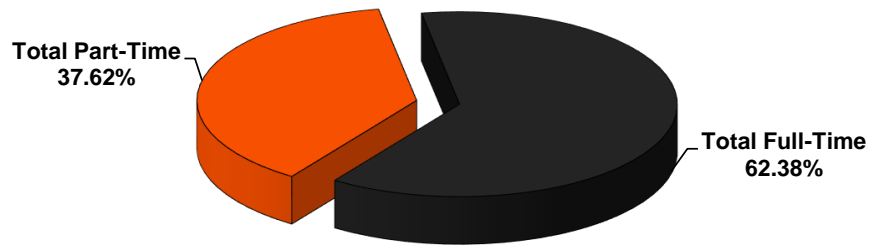

Summer 2018 Full-Time Enrollment by Sex

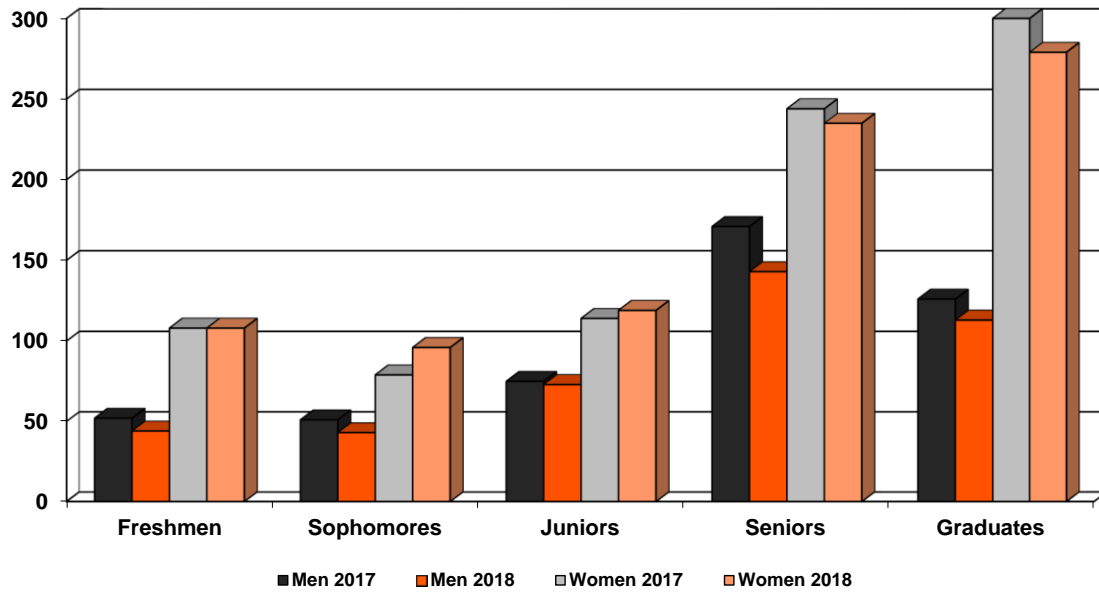


Summer 2018 Enrollment by Full-Time & Part-Time Status

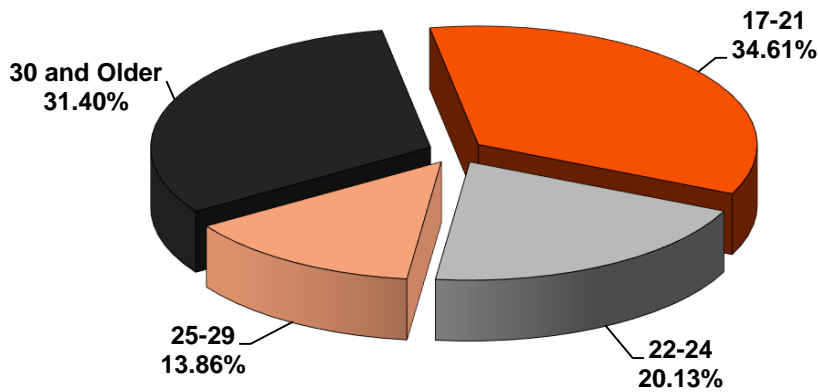

Summer 2018 Age Distribution Analysis of ECU Students



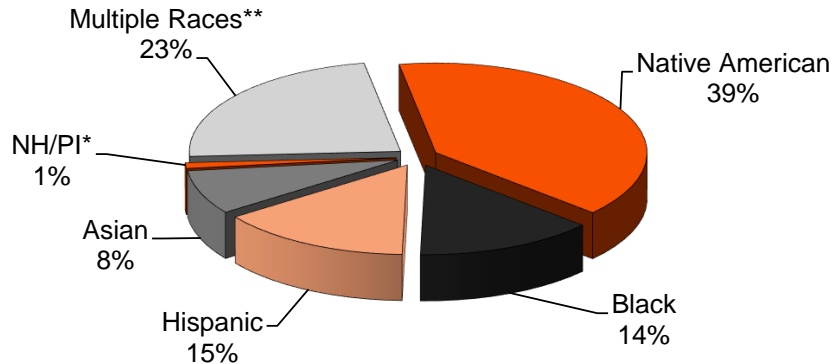

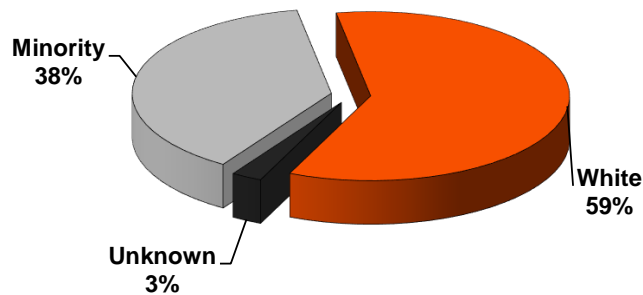

Minority and White Enrollment



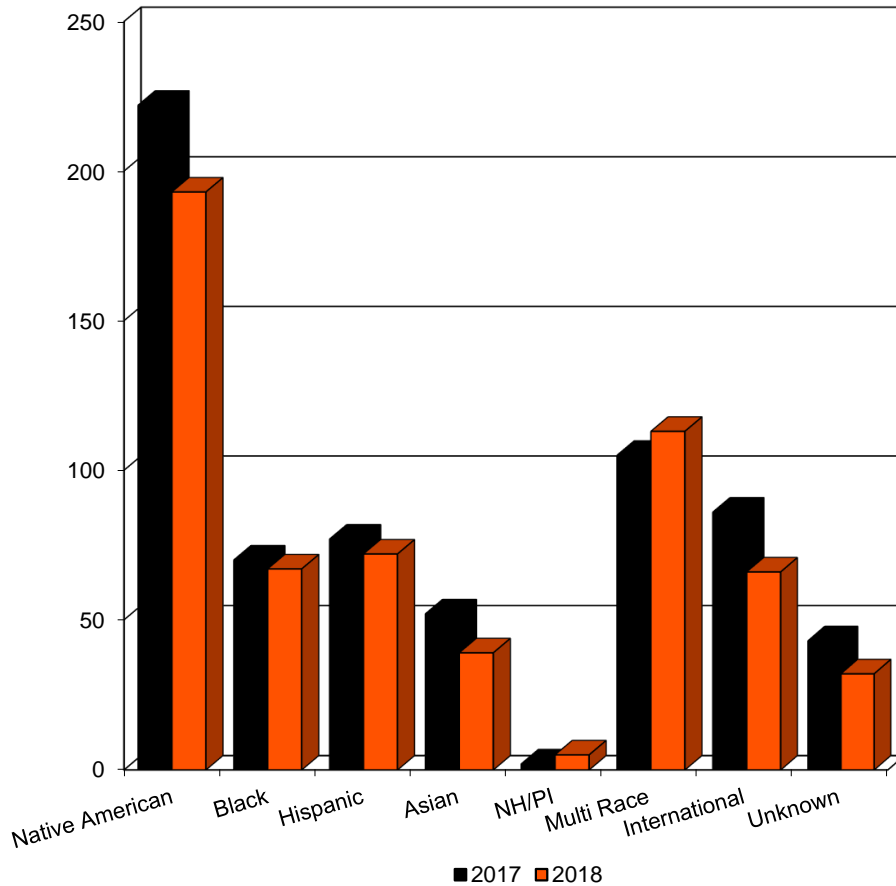

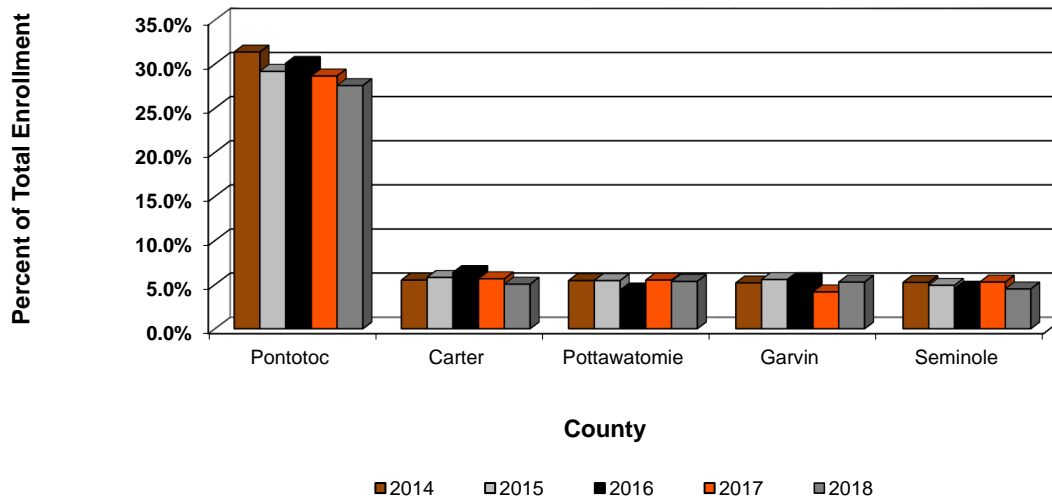

2018 Counties Accounting for an Average of Five Percent or More of Total Enrollment



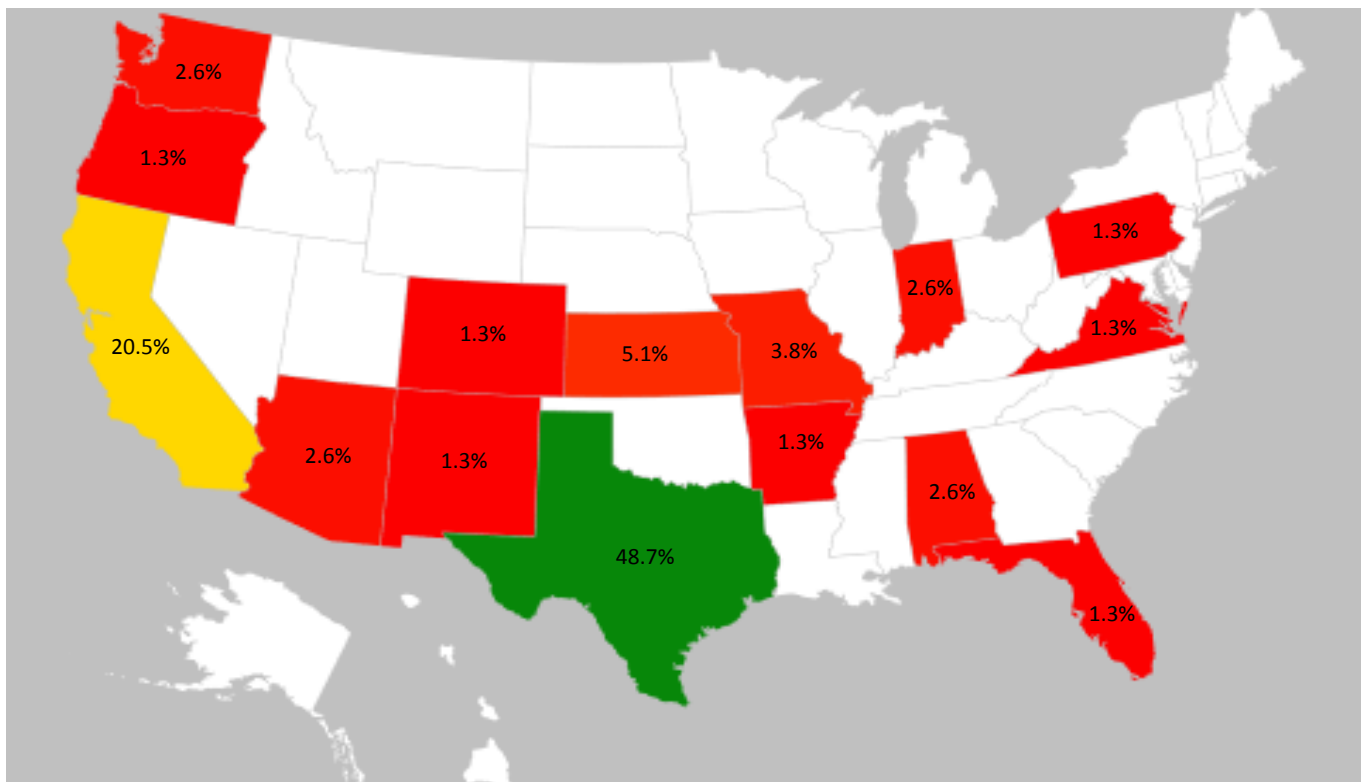

Distribution of Out-of-State Enrollment

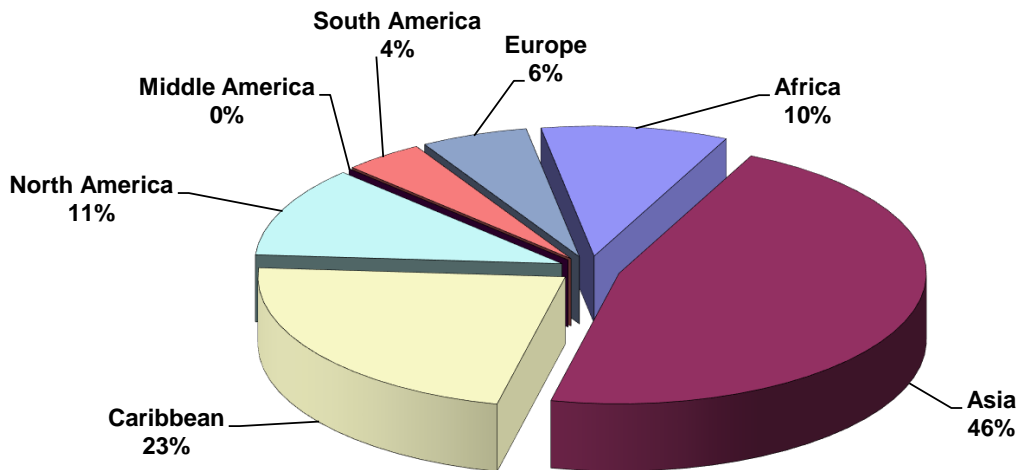

Summer 2018 International Student Enrollment by Geographic Area



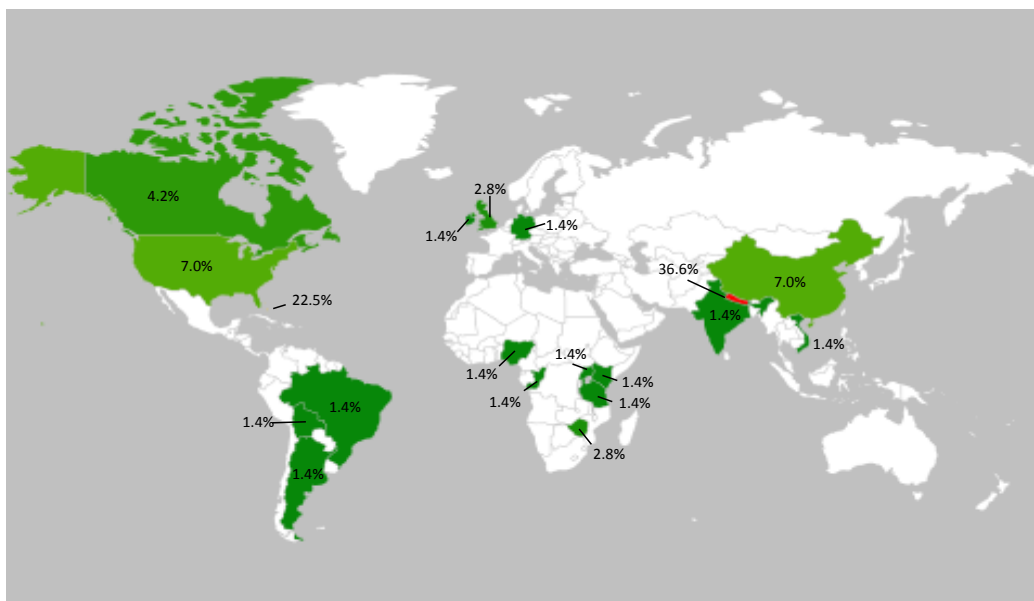
