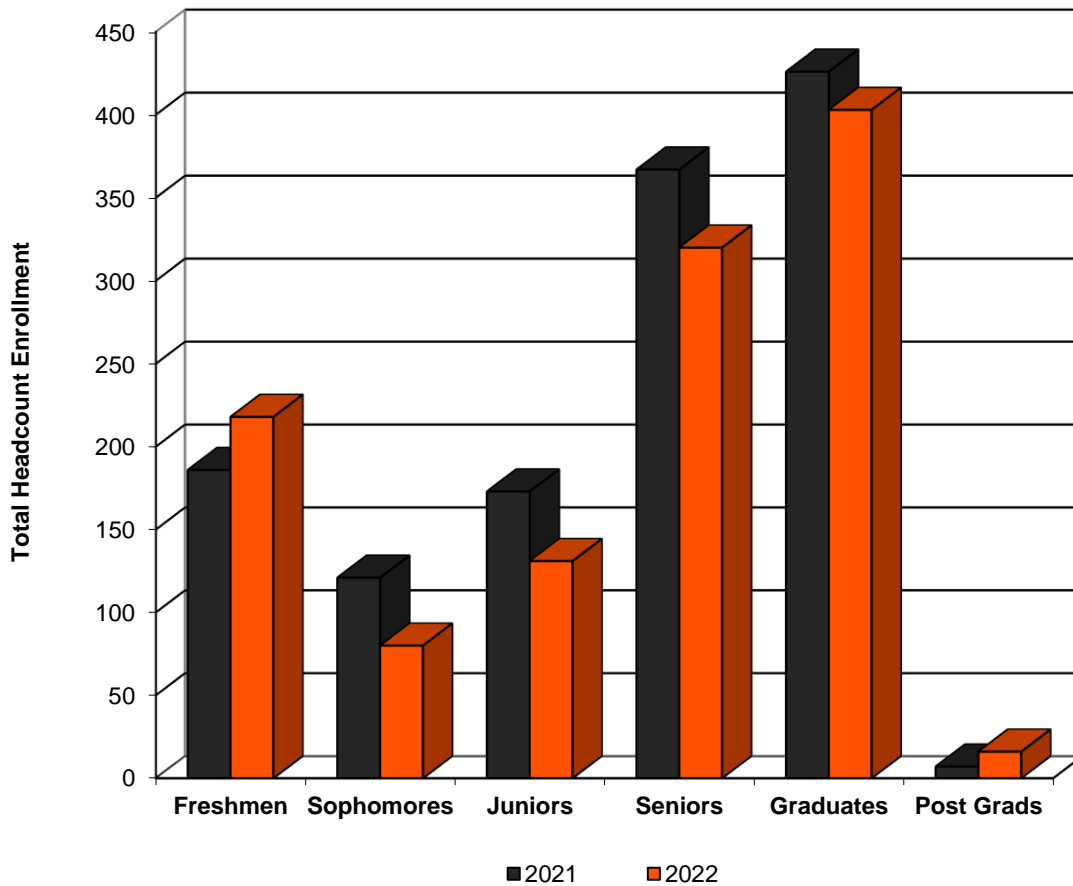

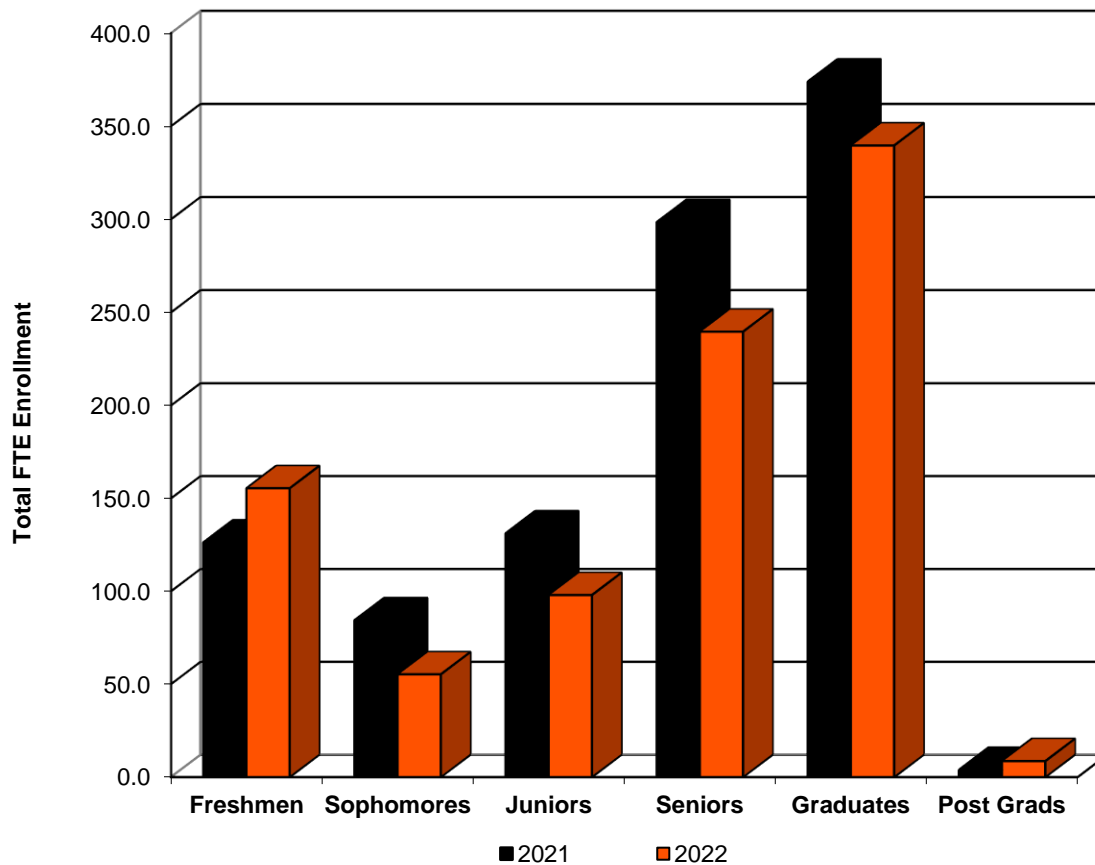

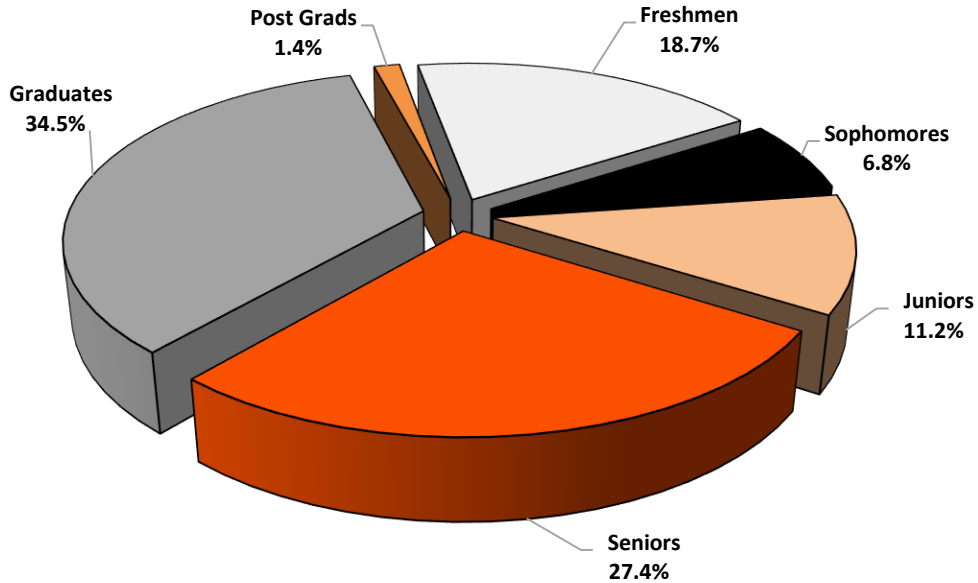

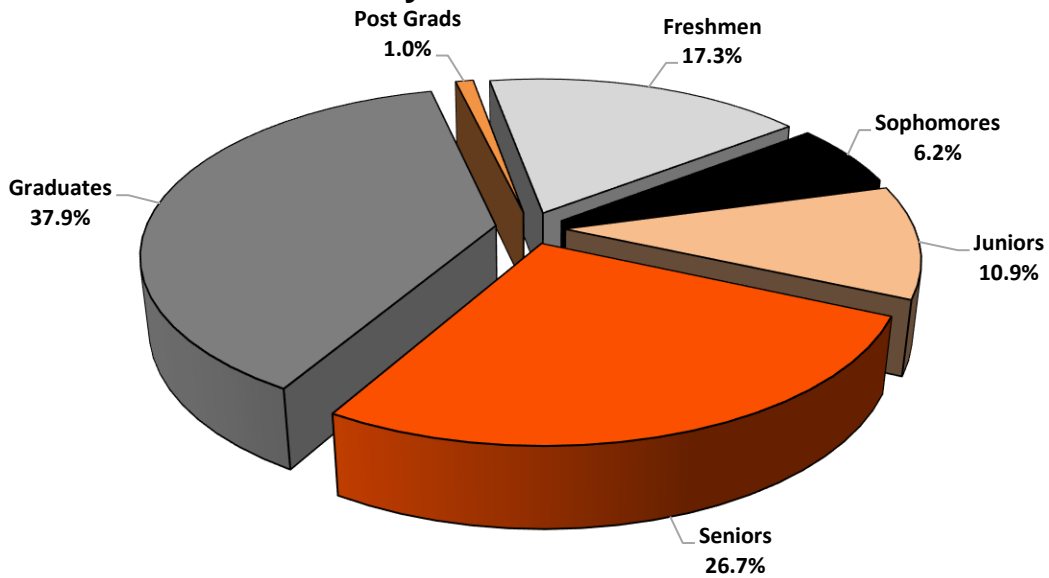


# Summer 2022 Headcount and FTE Enrollment

## Summer 2022 Headcount Enrollment by Classification

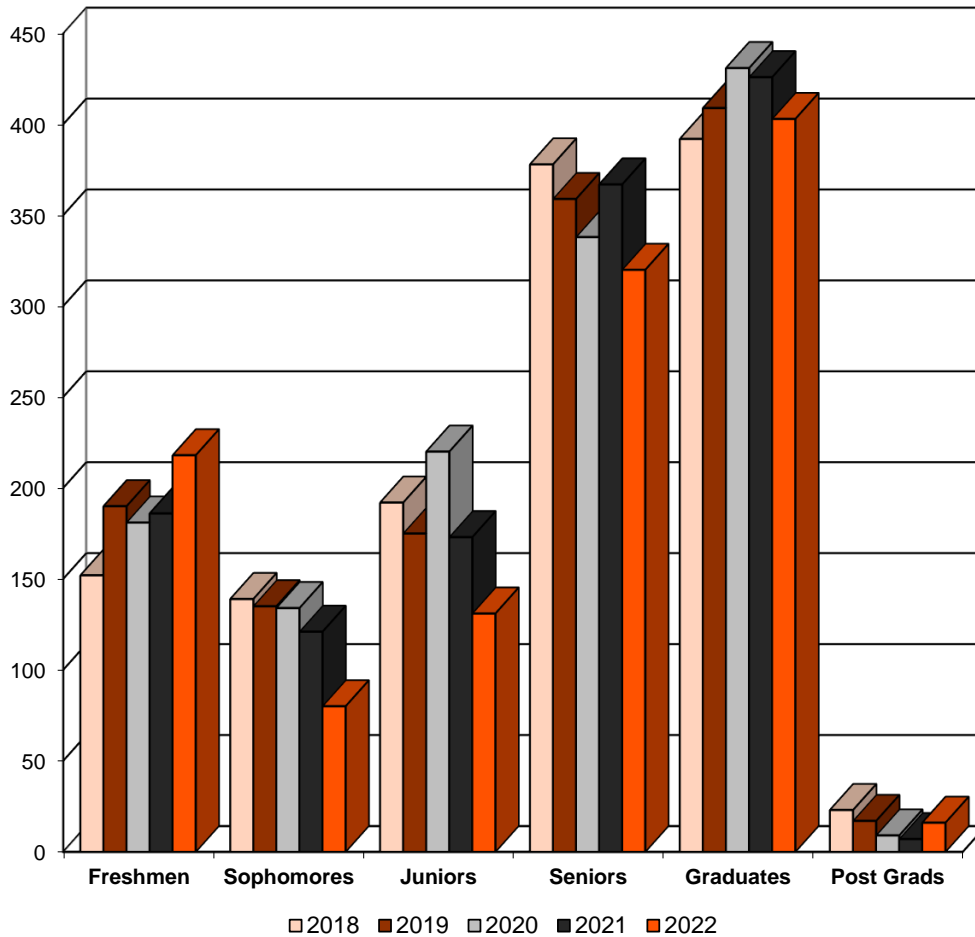


## Summer 2022 FTE Enrollment by Classification

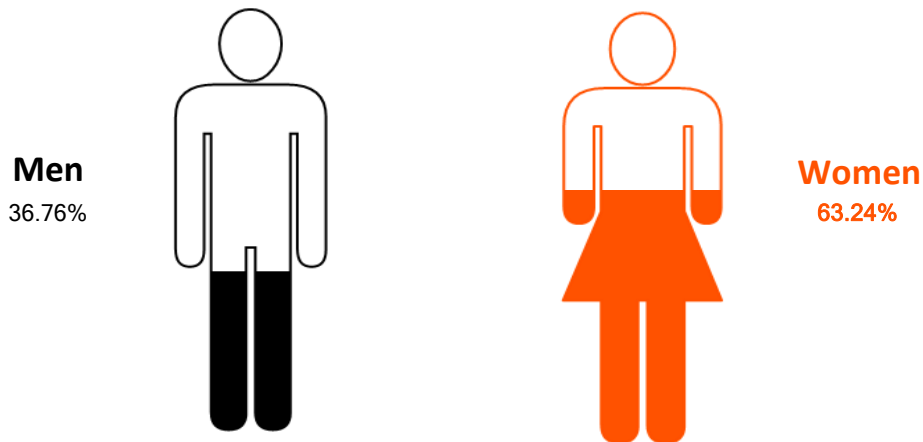

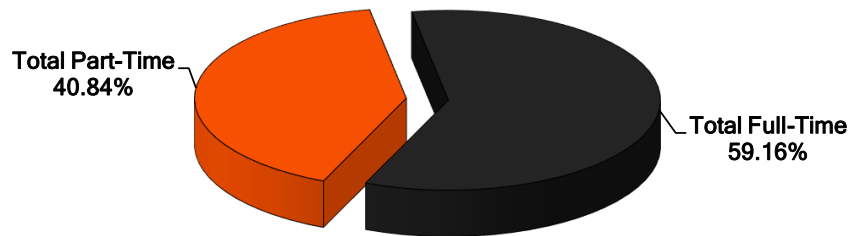

### Summer 2022 Full-Time Enrollment by Sex

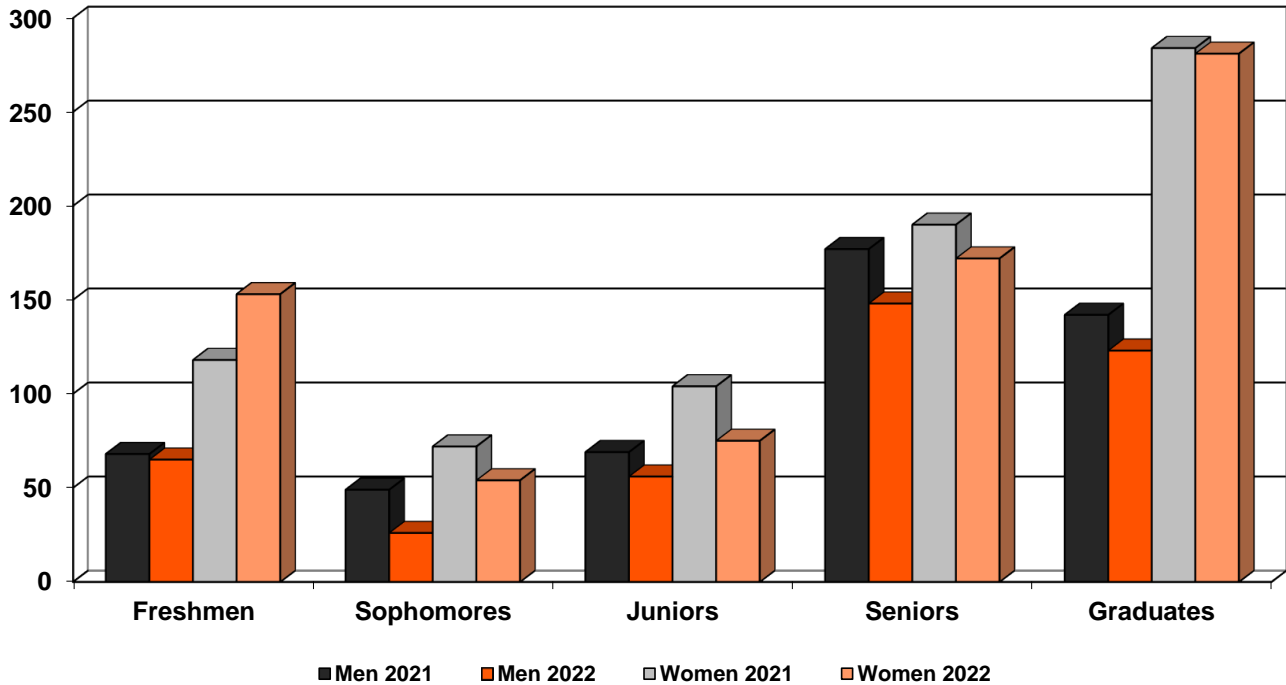


### Summer 2022 Enrollment by Full-Time & Part-Time Status

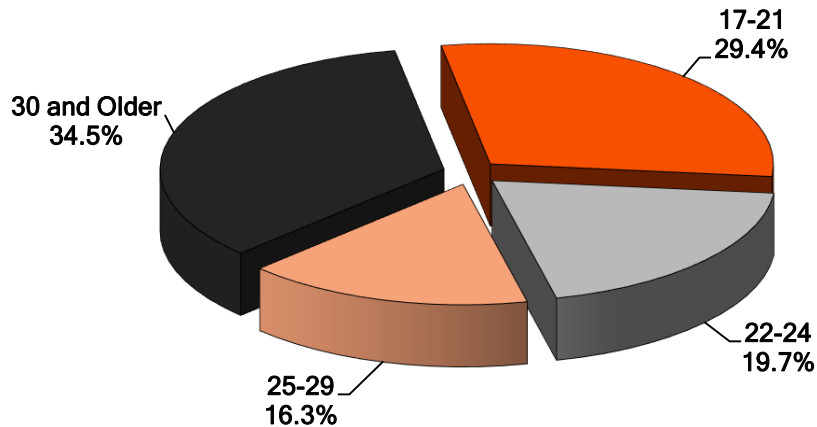

### Summer 2022 Age Distribution Analysis of ECU Students



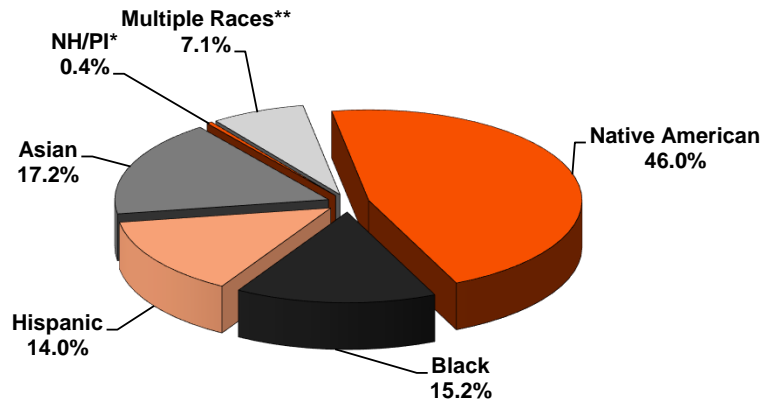

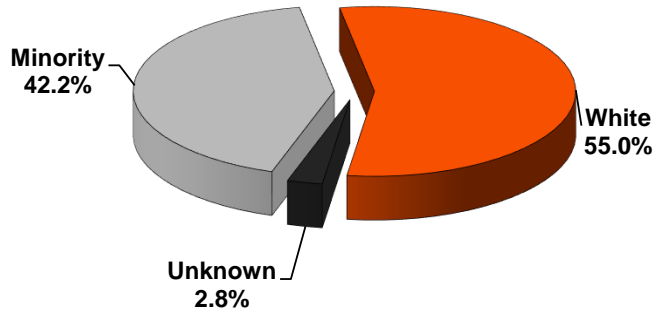

### Minority and White Enrollment





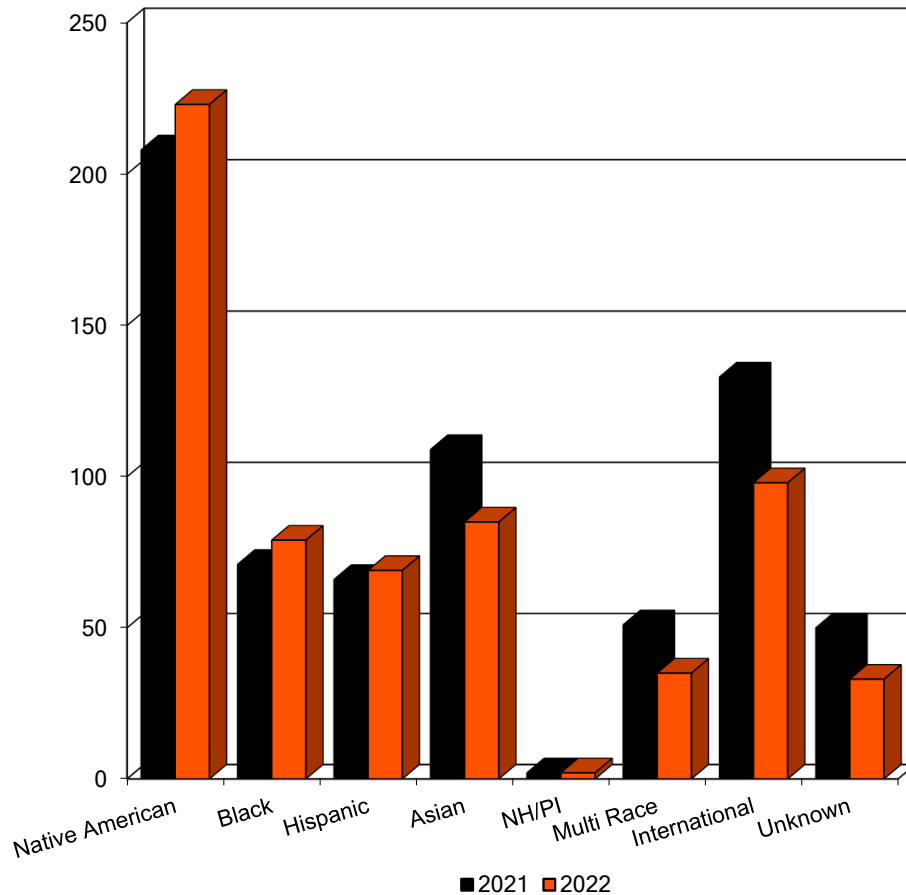

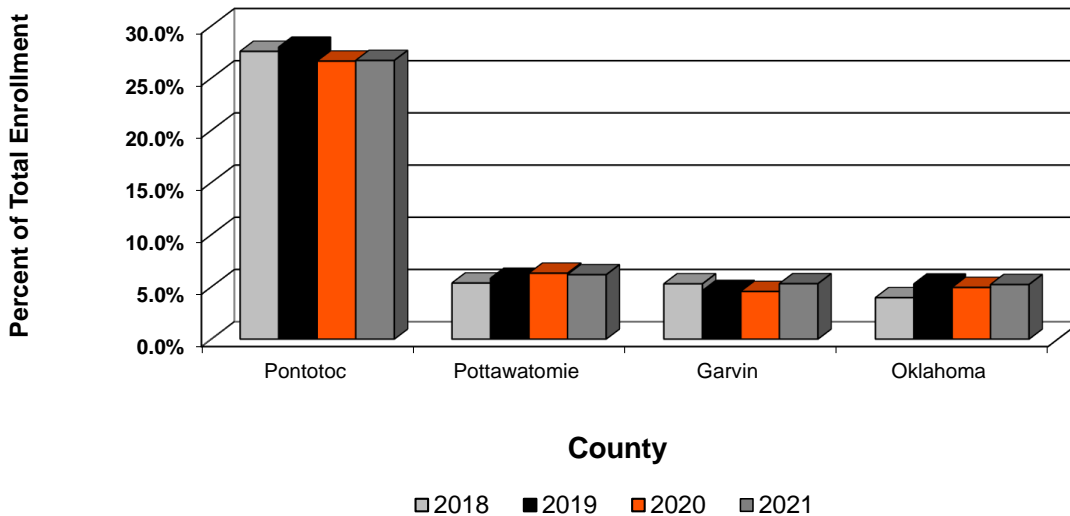

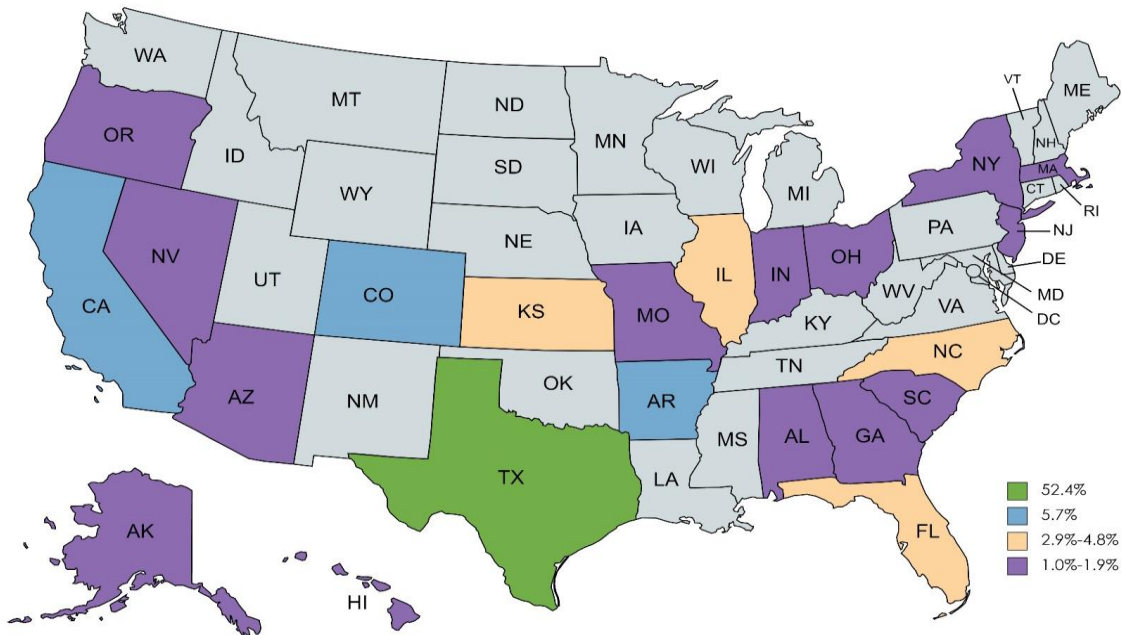

### Distribution of Out-of-State Enrollment



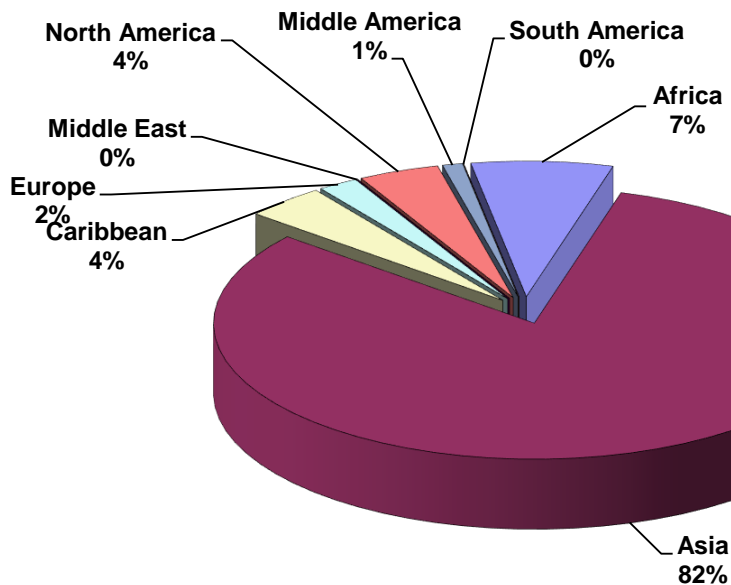
